## A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

All through the summer months, there were plenty of blank spaces in my appointment book. Those blank spaces are now starting to fill up rapidly. If your calendar is starting to fill up too, there are a couple of events you might want to be sure to write in.

On Sunday, September 10, we will hold our annual Mass in the Park. Mass will take place at Duffy Park at 11:00 AM. The Mass in the Park is an event that many people enjoy. Get your lawn chair ready and plan on joining us. We have had to move the venue a couple of times recently because of rain. Hopefully, the weather will cooperate this year and we'll be outside at Duffy Park. Please mark it down on your calendar and plan on joining us.

Saturday, September 9, is the National Day of Remembrance for Aborted Children. Solemn prayer vigils will be held throughout the country at designated memorial sites. The prayer vigils will commemorate the more than 50 million unborn children who have lost their lives to legal abortion since 1973, and to remind our society of the humanity of the unborn child. Here in our community, the memorial service will take place at St. Mary Cemetery at 1:00 PM. There will be signs to direct you to the site of the prayer service. Please try to join us for this event to pray for respect for life.

A new year begins for our School of Religion on Monday, September 11. Classes take place every Monday from 6:00 – 7:15 PM. If your children attend public school, please sign them up for the School of Religion. Students should enroll in the School of Religion in first grade and continue each year through eighth grade. This will help children to have the greatest growth in their faith, and also ensure that they are prepared for the reception of sacraments.
