A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

It is time again for the Annual Catholic Appeal. The Annual Catholic Appeal supports the work of the Church in the Archdiocese of Chicago. The Annual Catholic Appeal reminds us every year that we are part of a larger Church than just our parish. The Annual Catholic Appeal helps to support the wider work of the Church in our Archdiocese. Through the Annual Catholic Appeal, support is given to financially challenged parish communities. Support is given to their food pantries, soup kitchens, and other ministries that provide for basic needs. The Annual Catholic Appeal helps to support Catholic schools. The Annual Catholic Appeal supports lifelong formation. This includes programs to form and empower parish leadership and ministry. Many programs of ongoing education and ministry training are supported through the Annual Appeal. The Annual Catholic Appeal provides the funding for youth and young adult ministry. The Annual Catholic Appeal also helps support Catholic Relief Services, providing helping in the face of major emergencies around the world.

The theme of this year's Annual Catholic Appeal is, "Making All Things New.....God's Promise and Our Responsibility." The theme reminds us that God wants to make all things new. God is always at work bringing about a new and better world. The theme also reminds us that we have the responsibility to help make all things new. We do that by the generous sharing of our time, talent, and treasure. Our generous support of the Annual Catholic Appeal helps us to fulfill our responsibility.

The Annual Catholic Appeal will be conducted over the next three weekends. Next weekend, I will speak at all the Masses about the Appeal. The following week, we will hear a recorded message from Cardinal Cupich. We will then have the opportunity to fill out a commitment form for this year's Annual Appeal. The next weekend will be the follow-up for those who have not yet filled out a commitment form.

Please keep in mind that after a year off due to the pandemic, we will be going back to the previous format in which we are asked to fill out a commitment form in church. While many give through the mail or make on-line donations, we are still asked to fill out a form in church. We are asked to follow a specific format in conducting the Appeal. The way the Archdiocese determines whether the format is being followed or not is by the number of commitment forms turned in at Mass. That's why everyone is asked to fill out a commitment form at Mass, even if you already gave by mail or on-line or don't plan on participating this year. Please keep in mind that we are asked to make a pledge that can be fulfilled over 6 months or longer. Making a pledge rather than a one-time donation allows us to be more generous. Every parish is given a target figure for the Annual Catholic Appeal. The target figure is 7% of the parish's offertory income for the previous fiscal year. Our target for this year is \$46,821. Anything that is collected beyond this figure will be returned to the parish as a rebate.

If you have supported the Annual Catholic Appeal in recent years, you should have received the materials for this year's Annual Appeal in the mail. Some brochures are available at the ushers' tables in church. You can also go to the Archdiocese of Chicago website (www.archchicago.org). Click on "Giving" and you will be directed to information about the Annual Appeal. I hope we will all give some prayer and thought to this in the next week or two. I hope we will give our generous support to the 2022 Annual Catholic Appeal.

We are thankful to all that participated in making the project a great success, especially during this pandemic. We are grateful your parish continues to support our Life Saving Mission.


The Baby Bottle Project is an essential part of our organization's fundraising, so it is an incredible blessing to us and the women and babies we serve that we can count on your support year after year.
