## **A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

This past Tuesday, we received word that the wearing of masks would become optional in Catholic schools in Lake and suburban Cook counties, with a few exceptions, beginning Thursday, February 10. This only applied to the wearing of masks and not to other mitigation efforts. On Wednesday evening, I received word that the same mask-optional policy would begin in churches and chapels in Lake and suburban Cook counties, again with a few exceptions. As of February 10, masks are now optional in church for Masses and other liturgies. The mask-optional policy would also apply to Religious Education classes.

While this is no doubt welcome news to many, there are a few things we should keep in mind. The mask-optional only applies to Masses and other liturgies in church, to Catholic schools, and to Religious Education classes. Archdiocesan and parish offices, including parish halls and social gathering places, must wait until the governor's current statewide mask order is lifted on February 28 before moving to a mask-optional environment. Any COVID positive cases should still be reported to the parish office within 48 hours of symptoms or positive diagnosis if the individual has been on parish grounds so that close contacts can be notified. Isolation and quarantine protocols are not changing. Those who are symptomatic, or test positive, must still isolate. Unvaccinated close contacts must quarantine. Individuals coming out of isolation or quarantine will have to wear masks for an additional five days per CDC guidance. While masks are optional for now, they could become temporarily required again depending on infection rates. Restrictions on food and beverages are lifted, so we should be able to start having Hospitality Sundays again in the near future.

Even though masks are now optional, there are some who will still choose to wear masks. Others will choose not to wear masks. Either choice is fine. I hope we will realize that and be charitable towards one another. I hope we will avoid making judgments about another person's decision to wear a mask or not wear one. I hope we will consider the other person's point of view and realize they have valid reasons and concerns that have led them to the decision they have made. Let's make sure that in charity we respect those decisions and the reasons for them.

After almost two years of wearing masks, this will be a big change. It may make some people uneasy. There are still fears and concerns that many have. That is why we must be charitable and respectful to one another as we move forward. I know we can be. I hope we will be.

The Annual Catholic Appeal is being conducted over the next couple of weekends. I am speaking at all the Masses this weekend about the Annual Appeal. Next weekend, we will hear a recorded message from Cardinal Cupich. After that, we will be asked to fill out a commitment form for the Annual Appeal. The last weekend in February will be the follow-up weekend for the Annual Appeal. Please keep in mind that even though you may make a pledge to the Annual Appeal on-line or by mail, you should still fill out a commitment form at Mass. You can indicate on the form that you already gave. If you have supported the Annual Catholic Appeal in previous years, you should have received the materials for this year's Annual Appeal in the mail. If you have never made a pledge to the Annual Appeal, or if it's been a few years since you have, there are brochures about the Annual Appeal available at the ushers' tables in church. Please take one and read it. I hope we will all give some thought and prayer to this in the coming week. I hope we will try to generously support the 2022 Annual Catholic Appeal.

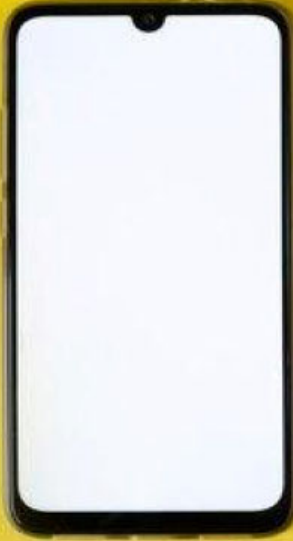
