## **A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

Next Sunday at 1:00 PM, Bishop Robert Casey will be here to administer the sacrament of Confirmation to the eighth-grade students in Most Holy Redeemer School and School of Religion. This sacrament will complete the initiation of these students into the Catholic Church. While a completion in one sense, it is also a beginning, the beginning for these young men and women of a lifetime of living out their faith in a more active and visible way.

Over the past few weeks, the students have been meeting for 10-15 minutes with Fr. Adamich, Deacon Mark Phelan, or myself for their Confirmation interview. While we all have different questions we ask, one thing I always speak with them about is what confirmation means. I use a lower case “c” here because we start out talking about what it means to confirm something – a doctor or dentist appointment or plans to do something with your friends. You confirm it to make sure of it. We go on from there to talk about what they confirm, or make people sure of, in the sacrament of Confirmation. They want to make people sure about them and their faith. They want everyone to be sure that they intend to continue to be members of the Catholic Church. Not only that, but they also want to confirm that they will be faithful and active members of the Church in the years to come, living out their faith in such a way that others will see it and be drawn to Christ.

I always find that the celebration of Confirmation makes me think about how I am doing in this regard. Even though it’s been over fifty years since I was confirmed, the effects of the sacrament remain. The work that sacrament gave me to do also remains. I think this is something good for all of us who are confirmed to think about. What are our lives confirming about us and our faith? Is our faith an active and visible part of our lives? Can people see that our faith makes a difference in the way we live? Is there anything we are doing that would draw anyone to Christ and to put their faith in Him?

I have always believed that one of the nice things about being a Catholic is that we always get a chance to start over again. As we pray for our eighth-grade Confirmation candidates, let’s keep in mind that what we confirmed when we received that sacrament holds true for the rest of our lives. Let’s make sure that we confirm that our faith means something in our lives. Let’s make sure we live it out in an active and visible way, a way that others can see, and a way that will hopefully lead them to our Lord and to put their faith in Him.

Lent will be here very soon. Lent is a time of increased prayer. Many people try to attend weekday Mass during Lent. While we will still just have 8:30 AM Mass Monday through Saturday, we will be having a Communion Service at 6:30 AM Monday through Friday during Lent. There will be a Mass on Ash Wednesday at 6:30 AM. The Communion Service will begin the day after. I hope that those who wish to receive the Eucharist before they go to work will try to take advantage of this.

Congratulations to parishioner and 2016 MHR graduate Abbey Murphy and her Olympic teammates on winning the silver medal in the women’s hockey competition at the Olympic Winter Games. Though not the hoped-for gold medal, silver is the next best thing. There will be another chance in Italy in four years. We want to thank Abbey for all the fun and excitement she and her teammates provided us with these past two weeks. Your parish family is very proud of you!

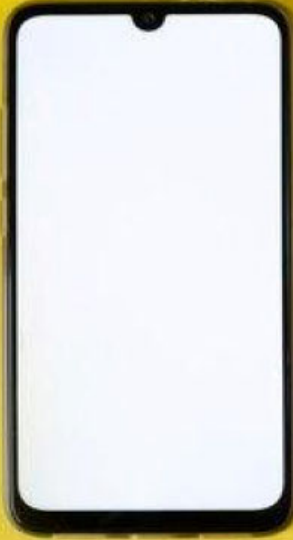
