A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Congratulations to all those students from Most Holy Redeemer School and School of Religion who received their First Holy Communion this weekend and to their families as well. First Holy Communion is a very important event each year in the life of our parish. It is always a very beautiful celebration. Beyond the beauty of the celebration, the truly important aspect of First Holy Communion is that it furthers the initiation of these children into the Church, an initiation that began in Baptism. These children will now be able to join us at the table of the Lord to share in the Eucharist.

I have come to believe that a child's second Holy Communion, and third Holy Communion, and ninth and tenth Holy Communion, and on and on are really more important than a child's First Holy Communion. I believe they are more important because they show that the reception of the Eucharist is becoming a regular part of a child's life. The Eucharist is meant to be received regularly, every Sunday or even more frequently. It is when we receive the Eucharist on a regular basis that it can do the most to strengthen us for doing our Lord's work. When we receive the Eucharist regularly it can do the most to help us grow as followers of our Lord. It's when the Eucharist is a regular part of our lives that it can do the most to draw us into a deeper union with our Lord and with the other members of our parish and the Church.

Years ago, at another parish where I served, I was standing in the back of the church waiting to start Mass. A young boy I knew from school stopped to say hello. He also told me how excited he was about being at Mass that day. I asked him why he was so excited. He told me, "I'm so excited because I'm making my second Holy Communion today!" I told him that was great, and I was glad he was so excited. But I saw the boy's parents standing nearby, and they looked like they wanted to shrink into a crack in the floor. The boy had made his First Holy Communion the past May. It was now the end of August.

I hope that for our First Communicants and their families, their second Holy Communion follows very soon after their first, hopefully the next day. I hope their third Holy Communion quickly follows the second, and on and on for the rest of their lives. Again, it's these receptions of the Eucharist that take place after the first one that show the Eucharist is becoming a regular part of their lives. The closer together these subsequent receptions of the Eucharist are, the greater benefit they will receive from this great sacrament.

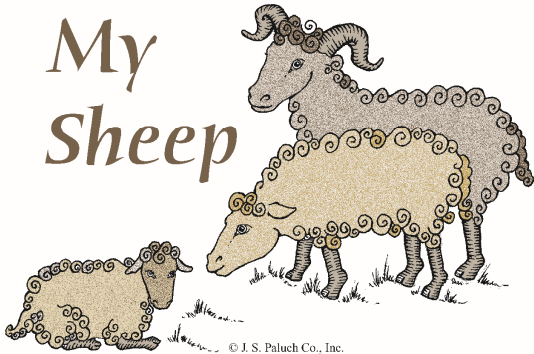
I hope we will all pray for our First Communicants, that they and their families will join us each Sunday at Mass to receive our Lord in the Eucharist, and, through the Eucharist, to grow closer to our Lord and to all the members of the Church. Let's also take a look at ourselves. Let's make sure that those subsequent receptions of the Eucharist in our lives are taking place regularly and without too much time in between them.

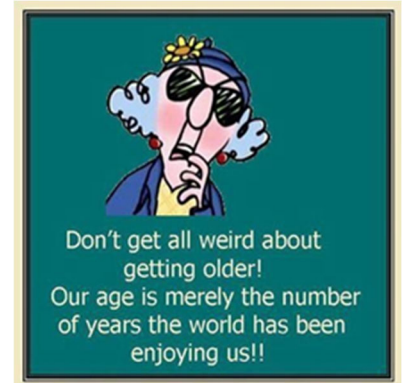

Date: Tuesday, May 3 **Time:** 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

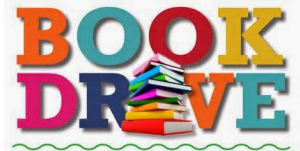

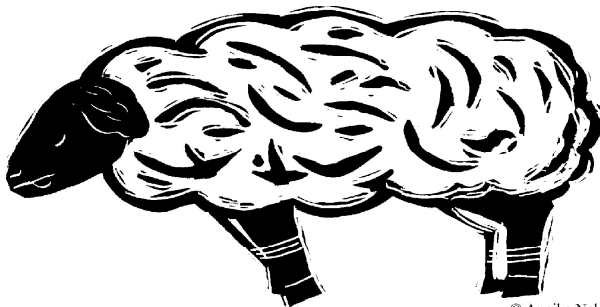


