## **A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

“Honor your father and your mother.” We all know that as the fourth of the Ten Commandments. I think most of us tend to think of this commandment as one we follow while we are young. We think of it in terms of obeying our parents, of doing what they tell us to do, of treating them with respect. I also think it’s a commandment we tend to grow out of, or think we do. I’m not breaking the seal of confession when I say this, but disobedience and disrespect towards parents are sins that are often confessed by young people. I don’t hear adults say they are disrespectful of their parents or fail to honor them. There is no age limit on any of the commandments though. Our parents are always our parents. What does it mean to honor them as we, and they, get older?

I bring this up because this weekend we celebrate Mother’s Day. It is a day on which we try to let our mothers know how much we appreciate them. It’s a day on which we try to let our mothers know how much we love them. It’s a day on which we try to let them know how important they have been, and still are, in our lives. That seemed to be a lot easier to do when I was younger. I could buy my mother something nice and she would be happy with it. When I was very young, I would try to be good all day, not disobeying or fighting with any siblings. That always seemed to make her especially happy.

My mom turned 96 a few weeks ago. In all honesty, a few years ago, I didn’t think she would make it another year. She doesn’t get around very well. She is weak and feeble. It takes her forever to do simple tasks, if she is able to do them at all. She forgets things, gets easily confused, and repeats things and asks the same questions over and over. Gifts for Mother’s Day, or Christmas, or her birthday mean very little to her at this point in her life. But she is still my mother, and many is the time I wrestle with what it means to honor her at this point in her life and mine.

Maybe it means that I give back to her now that she is old what she gave me when I was young. My mom was patient with me. Honoring her means I should now be patient with her when she forgets things, and repeats herself, and gets confused. My mom gave me her time, time she may have wanted to spend on other things. Honoring her means I give her my time, making sure I see her and spend time with her, not just on holidays or every couple of months, but as often as I can. My mom made sacrifices for me. Honoring her means I have to now be willing to make sacrifices for her, whether it’s to cancel something else to take her to the doctor or rearrange my schedule to watch her overnight.

I’m not trying to offer any quick and easy answers here. I’m just sharing with you something I wrestle with. Maybe you do too, or one day you will. Our mothers are always our mothers, and we are to always honor them. I think what that means and how we do it changes as we, and our mothers, go through life. At this point in your life, and in hers, what does it mean to honor your mother? It might be something good to think about on this Mother’s Day. Whatever thoughts come to mind, let’s try to honor our mothers, as we celebrate Mother’s Day and always, no matter how old we, or they, may be. Happy Mother’s Day!

Please join us next Sunday at the 11:00 AM Mass as we honor Fr. Adamich on his 100<sup>th</sup> birthday. Fr. Adamich will be the celebrant of the 11:00 Mass. A reception will follow Mass in Briody Hall where you can extend your birthday wishes to Fr. Adamich. Refreshments and birthday cake will be served. Please join us if you can.

This Sunday is the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. As parishes have been going through the initial stage of the *Renew My Church* initiative, we have seen closings of some parishes and the unification of others. Declining Mass attendance and financial issues have been two driving forces in the structural changes taking place in many parishes. Another important factor though, is the dwindling number of priests to care for the people in our parishes. Please pray for those who are currently studying to be priests. Also pray for those God is calling to be priests. God still calls, but that call is not always easy to answer in today’s world. Please pray for those God is calling, that they will be open to that call and answer it by saying, “Yes.”


