A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Memorial Day takes place on Monday. We will mark this day in a variety of ways. We will enjoy a day off from school or work. In many ways, this holiday marks the beginning of summer. School is out or soon will be. Graduations are taking place. We look forward to the summer and the leisure time we will enjoy. Maybe this is the weekend we get the grill and the yard ready for summer. We get the backyard pool ready if we have one, or maybe we head for the summer home if we have one. Maybe we enjoy the holiday by getting together with family and friends. Maybe we take in a parade or a Memorial Day sale at the store.

The fact that we are able to do any of these things on Memorial Day is a reminder to us about the true meaning of this holiday. The freedom we enjoy has come with a price tag attached. We enjoy what we enjoy because of the men and women who have defended our country in the armed forces. Many have given their lives in the wars our country has fought so that we can be free and enjoy the fruits of our freedom as we do. These are the ones we remember and honor on Memorial Day. We remember all who have given their lives in military service defending our nation. They are the reason we are able to celebrate Memorial Day in the many ways we do. There is a danger that we will overlook them as we celebrate Memorial Day.

As we celebrate Memorial Day, I hope we will remember what this holiday is really meant to celebrate and who it honors. Let's remember that the freedom we enjoy came at a price. Let's remember in our prayers all those who have given their lives defending our country in our armed forces. Let's pray for all those who currently defend our country. If you know anyone who is a veteran or currently serves in the military, be sure to say, "Thank you." Happy Memorial Day!

Our hearts were saddened earlier this week at the news of the school shooting in Texas. We pray for the victims and their families. This is just the latest chapter in the ongoing violence that plagues our nation. Many have already used this occasion as a call for stricter gun control. Others have said that we need to try to identify potential perpetrators earlier. Others are saying that we need to have armed guards at our schools to ensure the safety of our children.

While all these measures may have some merit, I don't think they will make any difference until we believe that all life is important and worthy of protection from the moment of conception until the moment when life naturally comes to an end. We are of the belief that some lives, especially the lives of the unborn, are not worthy of protection. As long as that is how we feel as a nation, we should not be surprised at the violence and disregard for life that plagues us. I find it ironic that some of the loudest voices I have heard calling for stricter gun control and other measures in the name of protecting our children were also the loudest voices complaining a few weeks ago about the possible overturning of Roe v. Wade. They want to protect children on one level, but on another level make it easier to end the life of an unborn child. I think there is a trickle-up effect at work here. If we aren't going to respect the life of an unborn child, why should we be surprised when life is not respected at other stages? You can't say that there is some magic moment at which we respect a life and before that we don't have to respect that life. You either respect all life at all stages of life or you don't. Sadly, we seem to have far too many people who are very selective about which lives they will respect. Oscar Wilde once wrote, "Consistency is the hallmark of the unimaginative." When it comes to human life, maybe we need to be a lot less imaginative and a lot more consistent. Until we are, we should not be surprised by the violence that plagues us. Just my opinion.
