A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

A year makes a big difference. Last year, the pandemic caused graduation ceremonies to be greatly altered. Graduations did not take place on the assigned dates. Some were delayed until later in the summer in the hope of having a ceremony that was a little more traditional. Other schools went ahead with drive-by ceremonies or virtual graduations instead of the traditional ceremonies in churches or auditoriums or stadiums. A lot of the events surrounding graduation such as class trips and proms and awards ceremonies did not take place.

This year, things are a little more normal. Graduations are taking place on their scheduled dates and are taking place in-person rather than virtually or as drive-by ceremonies. While attendance may be limited and some other ceremonies are still suspended, graduation is a lot more normal this year than last. Hopefully, next year we'll be back to our traditional ceremonies with all the accompanying pomp and circumstance.

One thing that has stayed the same, pandemic or not, is the way we usually think of a graduation as opposed to the way we should think of it. We usually think of graduation as a conclusion. Whether it's pre-school, kindergarten, grade school, high school, or college, graduation brings a conclusion to one phase of our education. We're outta here. We're done. That's how we tend to think of graduation.

Graduation is also known by another name – commencement. I like that name better. Commencement means that something is beginning. Rather than thinking that something is over or ending, I think it's better to think that something new is beginning. A new phase of our education may be commencing as we move on to the next level. A new phase of life may be commencing as we move into the work world.

Whatever part of their lives may be commencing for this year's graduates, we take what we have learned at one level and build on that in the next. The lessons we build on are not always academic lessons. They may be lessons we learn about how to treat other people and work with them. They may be lessons about applying ourselves and doing our best. Maybe the lessons we build on are lessons about values and what is most important in life. Maybe we build on the lessons of our faith.

For all the graduates from our parish at whatever level, we hope that as you commence on a new phase of your lives you will be happy and successful. We hope you will build on what you have learned previously, especially on those non-academic lessons that are often more important and valuable. Congratulations to all the 2021 graduates from our parish!

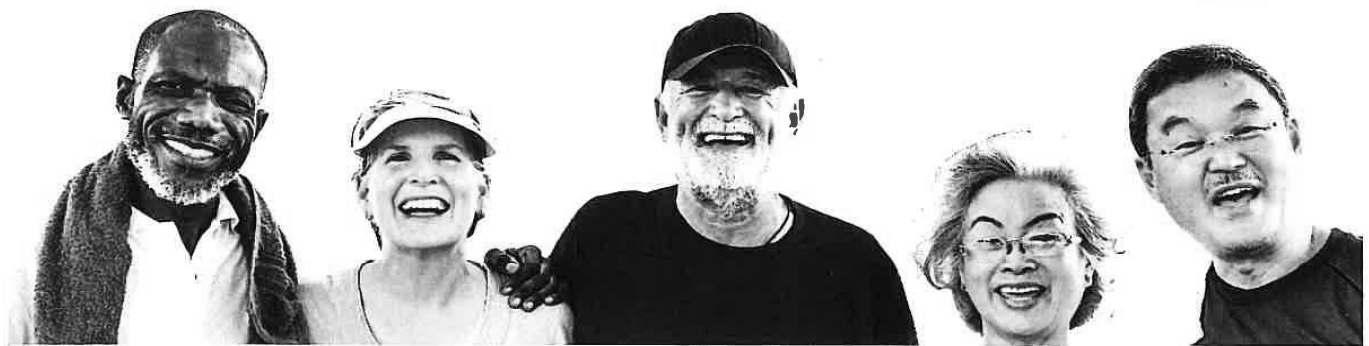
