We, the family of Most Holy Redeemer Parish, commit ourselves to enriching our relationship with God by following the teachings of Jesus Christ. With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we continue to build the Kingdom of God in our midst. Our vision is to foster the faith of all through prayer, service, education, and ministry.

A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Normally, this would have been the week for our annual Parish Carnival. Unfortunately, as you may have heard, we had to reschedule the Carnival for later in the summer. The new dates are July 21-24. I hope to fill you in on what happened this weekend.

Our Carnival provider, Windy City Amusements, gets a lot of seasonal employees to work for them during the summer months. They need visas to come here and work. We received a message on May 28 that they had not received enough visas for their workers and had to wait for more to be issued by the government. After the government issued more visas, they would have to go into a lottery to see how many they could obtain for their seasonal workers. This meant that they did not have enough workers available this week to cover our Carnival and another community festival they had scheduled.

That left us with a couple of options. We could cancel the Carnival, which no one wanted to do. We could try to find another company to come in to provide the rides and other attractions for us on the original dates of June 16-19. We tried to find another company to come in but were told they couldn't handle it on those dates. This left us with our third option of rescheduling the Carnival. We were given alternate dates by Windy City Amusements in July and in late August. The Carnival Committee members felt the July dates would work better, so we rescheduled with Windy City for the July dates previously mentioned. We have been told by Windy City that the additional visas they need have been obtained, and enough workers should be available to take care of us in July.

While we have rescheduled with Windy City Amusements, we still have to reschedule with our food vendors, our bands, and suppliers. We also have to reschedule our volunteers. We hope that our bands, food vendors, and other suppliers will be able to still be with us in July. I'm very sorry if the change in dates means they will not be able to join us. If they can't make it, our Carnival Committee will have to find new bands, vendors, and suppliers to take their place.

Even though the Grand Raffle tickets have a date printed on them for the drawing, we will push the drawing back to the Carnival. You'll have to wait another month to win. We also hope that the change in dates doesn't mean we will lose some of our Carnival sponsors.

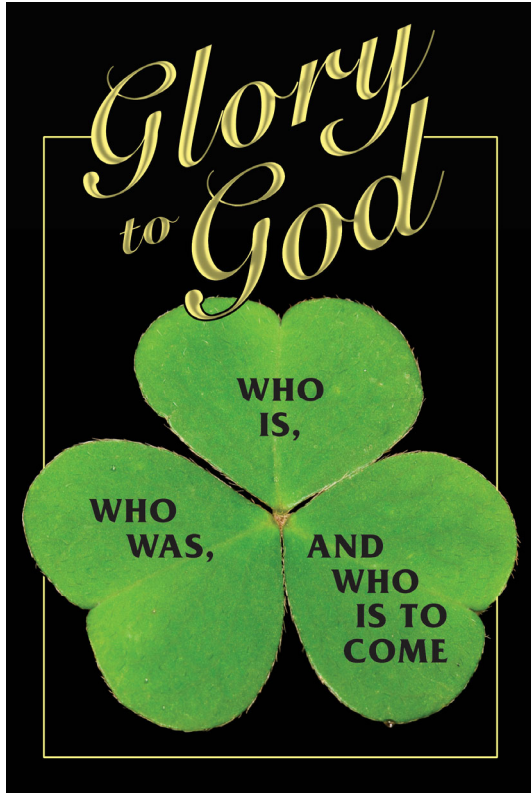
We will still need many volunteers to make the Carnival a success. I know the change in dates may mean we lose some of our workers who have vacations and other events scheduled for July 21-24. I do hope though, that if you are available, you would be willing to come out and volunteer to help make this event a success once again. The Carnival is our biggest fundraiser and helps us to meet our financial obligations. It is very important to our parish.

I hope this helps you understand a little better what happened and why we had to reschedule. The good news is we will have a Carnival this summer. I hope you will be willing to give some of your time to help make it a success once again.

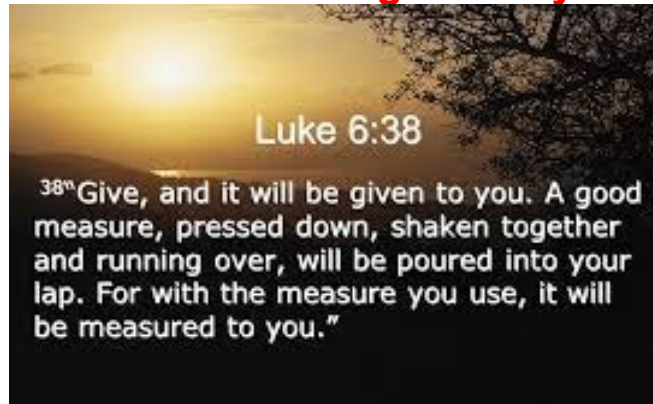
MHR St Vincent DePaul's mission is to assist people living in MHR Parish boundaries in times of need.


