When she accepted the job of being our new religious education director, I don't think she could have imagined what challenges lay before her. She has done a great job in ensuring that our children received the proper religious instruction and that our sacramental celebrations were appropriate. She is to be commended for that.

While we look forward to a break from many of our activities, let's remember that we never take a break from our faith. 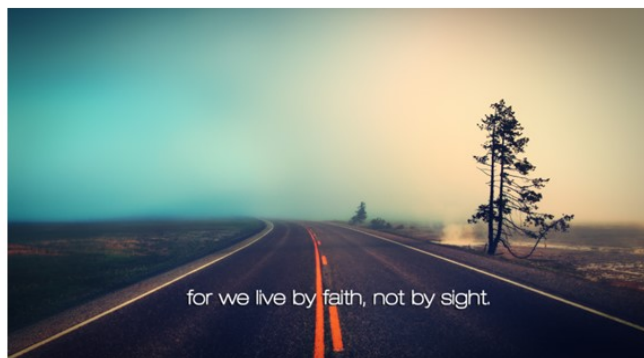
