MISSION STATEMENT

We, the family of Most Holy Redeemer Parish, commit ourselves to enriching our relationship with God by following the teachings of Jesus Christ. With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we continue to build the Kingdom of God in our midst. Our vision is to foster the faith of all through prayer, service, education, and ministry.

A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. This feast offers us the opportunity to reflect on the great gift of the Eucharist. The Eucharist is central to our lives as Catholics. At the Last Supper, Jesus clearly said after taking bread into His hands, "This is My Body," and taking the chalice of wine, "This is My Blood," then, "Do this in remembrance of Me." We fulfill our Lord's desire that we "do this" in His memory every time we participate in the Eucharist.

Despite our Lord's desire that we celebrate the Eucharist in His memory and the centrality it has to our lives as Catholics, it's no secret that participation at Mass and the Eucharist has declined significantly. To that end, the National Council of Catholic Bishops is launching a National Eucharistic Revival that begins this weekend. The Revival is a three-year initiative to form, heal, convert, and unite the People of God through a renewed encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist and then to send them out to a hurting and hungry world. The Revival's focus on formation and missionary discipleship begins at the grassroots level in individual parishes and dioceses along with other Catholic institutions.

The Revival is a three-year initiative. Year One is the Year of Diocesan Revival in which U.S. bishops respond to the Lord's personal invitation and empower their priests and parish leaders to host events with a Eucharistic focus. Year Two is planned as the Year of Parish Revival. Individual pastors will engage their staff and parishioners with community-specific activities and events to better understand and enter more deeply into the Paschal Mystery through the celebration of the Mass, and extended opportunities for Adoration and Reconciliation. Year Three will be the Year of the National Eucharistic Congress and Missionary Sending. Year Three will commence with a National Eucharistic Congress set to take place July 17-21, 2024, in Indianapolis.

There will be more about the National Eucharistic Revival as it develops. Maybe we can begin this weekend to reflect in our own lives upon the Eucharist. What role does the Eucharist play in our lives? How central is the Eucharist to us as followers of Christ? How do we fulfill our Lord's desire that we "do this in remembrance of Him?"

This weekend, we also are celebrating Fathers' Day in the United States. We take time this weekend to honor our fathers. We recognize the gift they are in our lives. We thank them for all they do for us. It's also a time for fathers to recognize the role they play in the lives of their children and families. A father's role goes beyond being a breadwinner, or being the disciplinarian in the family, or teaching children how to play baseball or go fishing. It has been shown that children who have a father present in the home are less likely to exhibit delinquency and behavioral problems. Children who have a father present in the home tend to achieve better academically and are less likely to be poor as adults. There are all kinds of social problems that are less likely to affect children, from substance abuse to teenage pregnancy, when a father is present in the home and actively engaged in the lives of his children. There is a further impact that fathers provide when they are the religious leaders in their families. Those children will be more likely to have stable marriages and be more religious themselves as adults. As we celebrate Fathers' Day, I hope we will be thankful for our fathers and the role they play in our lives. I hope fathers will begin to realize how great their impact is on their children, maybe in ways they hadn't realized before, and they will try to be the best fathers they can for their families. Happy Fathers' Day!

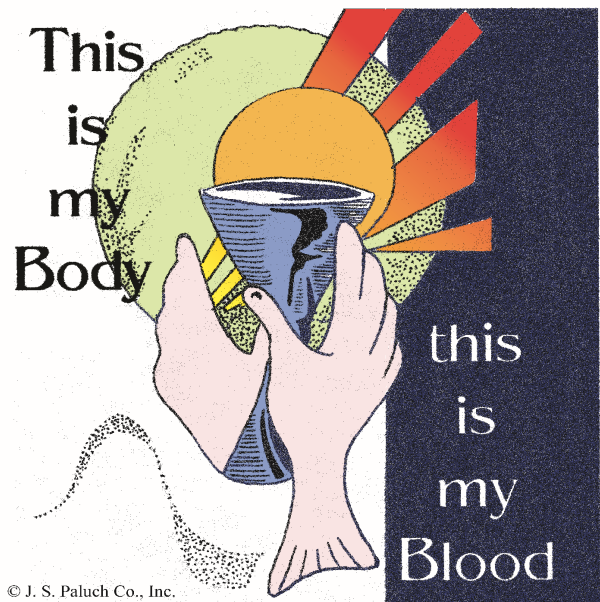
