## A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Years ago, I was at a meeting of a men's Christ Renews His Parish team. We were talking about the Eucharist that evening. The topic of attending Sunday Mass was part of the conversation. The men were talking about Mass and about why they attended, or why they didn't. One man said something I always remember. He said that he went to Mass because his father went to Mass. He said, "Both my parents went to Mass, but my father going meant something more. Because my father went, I knew it was really important. Even when I was away at college with no one to check up on me, I went to Mass at the Newman Center every Sunday. I knew it was important to go to Mass, and I knew it was important because my father went to Mass."

Fathers have that kind of influence. It's not that mothers don't also set a good example for their children and help instill the proper values and behaviors. They do. But when you see your father doing something, it has a little more impact. That is especially true when it comes to our faith. In baptism, parents commit themselves to being the first teachers of their children in the faith. By word and example, they teach the faith to their children and bring them up in the practice of the faith. That responsibility is not something that ends when children start school. Catholic schools and Religious Education Programs are to assist parents in their role as the primary religious educators of their children. They don't take over that role.

As we celebrate Father's Day this weekend, we think about our fathers and all we have to be thankful for about them. It is also an opportunity for fathers to reflect on their role as fathers. I hope that we will think about the role fathers play as primary religious educators of their children. Fathers do have a great impact in this area, maybe a lot more than they realize.

Maybe we would agree with the man in that Christ Renews His Parish meeting. What our fathers do when it comes to the faith means a little bit more. Maybe we have a greater appreciation of the Mass, the sacraments, prayer, works of charity, forgiveness, generosity, volunteering your time, and being active in your parish because we saw our fathers do those things. Because we saw our fathers, as well as our mothers, do those things, we knew they were really important.

Considering that, fathers should ask themselves if they are showing their children the importance of faith and religious practice. If you're a father, do your children see you going to Mass on Sunday? Do they ever see you rearrange your schedule or get up earlier so you can attend Mass on a busy weekend instead of just excusing yourself because you have a lot of other things going on? Do your children ever see you pray? Do they see you volunteer your time? Do they see you act honestly? Do they see you show generosity? Do they see you forgive?

I know that even with the good example of both parents, children may turn away from their faith and from the Church. It is often a source of great frustration and sadness for parents when they do. But that shouldn't stop parents from continuing to set that religious example. If does let children know that faith and religious practice do matter. When fathers set that example, it does have a little more impact.

As we give thanks for our fathers this weekend, maybe we can be especially appreciative for the example of faith our fathers have set for us. Maybe fathers can also come to see that as a much more important part of their role as fathers. Happy Father's Day!





## **“HARLAN STYLE” PRAYER & BONFIRE NIGHT!**


