A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

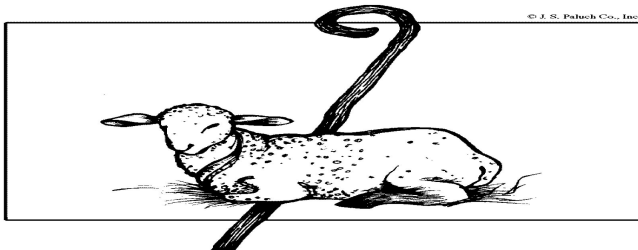
I haven't met anyone so far who isn't happy that we will have a Carnival this year. Even though the dates are different, and it will be scaled back a little, people are very happy we will be having this event and are looking forward to it. Raising some needed funds for our parish will be important. But even more important is the opportunity to come together as a community, especially after all we have gone through with the pandemic. Our Carnival Committee is to be commended for the work they are doing to get things ready, and also for their confidence that we could put a Carnival together on short notice.

Even with all the work the Carnival Committee is doing, an event like this doesn't happen without a lot of help from a lot of people. We need a lot of volunteers to work at the Carnival. Please be willing to work a couple of hours to help make this event a success. You can call the rectory (708-425-5354) if you want to volunteer to help. You can also sign up at the parish website (www.mostholyredeemer.org). Please be willing to give some of your time to help out at the Carnival.

There has been some repair work going on at the school building. There was tuckpointing that needed to be done on the upper side walls of the original school building. That work has been completed. I had said a while back that the school needs a new roof. That hasn't changed. The school still needs a new roof. We are going to have to wait until next summer to have this work done though. Because roofers are experiencing material shortages, we don't know when the work would be able to be done. This would be a complete replacement, which means new insulation would be needed, and that's where the shortage is. The roofers we have talked to would not be able to do the work before school opens for the new year. We can't have this work done with students and teachers in the building. Therefore, we will have to wait. We did have the roof patched. After the patching was done, we had those heavy storms a few weeks ago. We did not have any water come into the building. The hope is that we'll get through the year alright, and then get the new roof next summer. This will also give us some time to get the money together to pay for the roof. It will not be cheap. Work will start soon on repairing the classrooms that were damaged because of the leaks in the roof this past year. That work will be covered by insurance.

When school got out for the summer, I mentioned the teachers who were retiring or not returning. Since then, there are a few more of our teachers who will not be returning next year. After over twenty years of teaching at Most Holy Redeemer, Mrs. Norah O' Malley will be leaving us. Ms. Megan Mattia and Ms. Lauren Provenzano will also not be returning. This is sad for us because they were all very fine teachers. We want to thank them for all they did for our students, our families, our school, and our parish over the year. They will be missed. We wish them all the best and much success in their future endeavors. We are interviewing potential replacements. Please pray that we will find good teachers to take their place.
