With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we continue to build the Kingdom of God in our midst. Our vision is to foster the faith of all through prayer, service, education, and ministry.

A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Our Carnival concludes Sunday afternoon and evening. If you haven't been out yet, we hope to see you. If you have already been to the Carnival, we hope to see you again on Sunday. There will be plenty of food and entertainment. There will be a ride special until 7:00 PM. The beer garden will be open, and hopefully, the last Queen is still standing, and someone will win a nice prize. This is the first parish-wide social event we have had since the pandemic started. I hope you will come out to not only help us raise some needed funds for the parish, but also to see your friends and neighbors who you may not have seen in a while.

In previous years, we always had a visitor come to us during the summer months to speak about the missions. The person would speak at all the Masses one weekend, highlighting the work of missionaries around the world and usually sharing some of their own personal experiences of working in the missions. The speaker would ask for our prayers in support of all who work in the missions. A collection would also be taken up to aid the missionaries in their work. Due to the pandemic, we did not have a mission speaker last summer, nor will we have one this summer.

These Summer Mission Appeals took place on different weekends, depending on the availability of the mission speakers. While the speakers will not be visiting parishes this summer, we are still asked to support the work of the missions. Next weekend throughout the Archdiocese there will a collection to support the missionaries in their work. This is not only a chance to support the work of the missions, but also to remind ourselves of the missionary nature of the Church. Our Lord told His Apostles to go out to all the world and preach the gospel. Our support of the missions helps to accomplish this work. I announced at the end of May who the members of our Grouping Feedback and Discernment Team for the *Renew My Church* initiative would be. In case you forgot, they are Christ Brett, Lee Ann Arethas, Pat Enright, Ron Balsewich, Nicole Cushing, and myself. Dan Turney, our new principal, will be attending the *Renew My Church* meetings as well. We had an initial meeting with the teams from St. Bernadette and Queen of Martyrs at the beginning of June. As we enter August, this process will be ramping up. We will be meeting together every other week beginning this Tuesday. Very simply, what we are trying to do is figure out is how we can best carry on the work of our Lord here in our community in the future. What must we do to accomplish that? Which is the best path forward to a sustainable, vibrant, and vital Catholic presence for our shared community? We do not know what this means at this point or what form it will take. We don't know what changes may take place as we move forward. You will be kept posted as things develop through the bulletin and our social media. I ask you to pray for the success of *Renew My Church* here in our community. Keep in mind too, that this is a work of renewal. As renewal, this is the work of the Holy Spirit. Please try to also keep an open mind about where the Spirit may lead us.

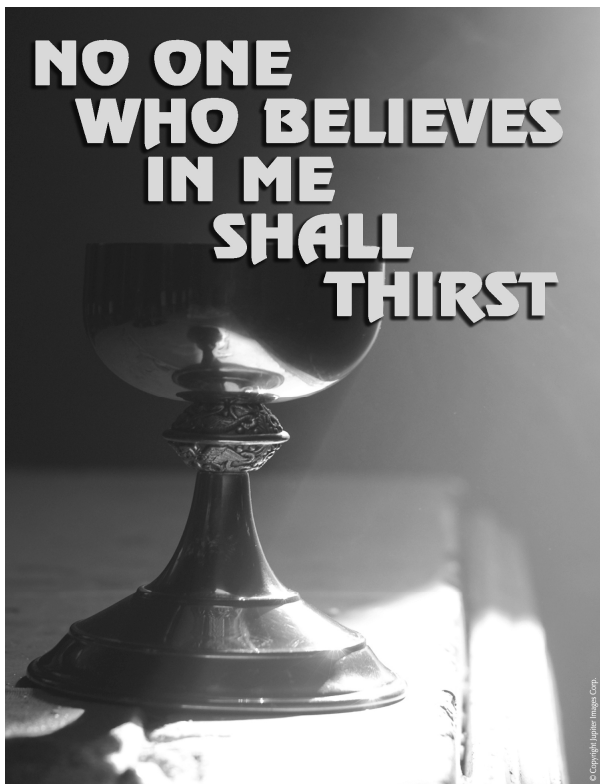

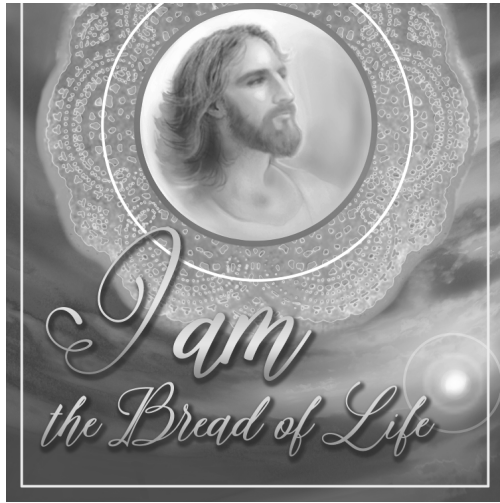
