A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Every year, parishes across the country take part in the Summer Mission Appeal. Missionaries visit parishes across the country to speak about the work of the foreign missions and to solicit our financial and prayer support. Because of the pandemic, missionaries have not been able to visit parishes to talk for the past two summers. This year, they are able to resume making parish visits.

This weekend, our parish will be taking part in the Summer Mission Appeal. We welcome Fr. Robert Ayebazibwe to Most Holy Redeemer. Fr. Robert is a priest from Uganda in East Africa. He will be speaking on behalf of Friends for Shalom for Uganda. Friends for Shalom for Uganda is a U.S. not-for-profit organization that provides charitable assistance to Mary Queen of Heaven Community Medical Center of St. Joseph's Parish, Nyakyera, Archdiocese of Mbarara, Uganda, and the people in the village of Nyakyera and the surrounding Ntungamo District. Friends for Shalom for Uganda is a non-political, non-sectarian, faith-based organization which built the first dedicated Community Medical Center to give the most vulnerable children, mothers, and their families the opportunity to survive and thrive.

A second collection to support the missionaries will be taken up. Our generous support will help Friends for Shalom for Uganda to provide needed medical supplies and equipment to the people of Uganda. I hope we will make Fr. Robert feel welcome, and that we will respond generously to the Summer Mission Appeal.

While we do want to offer our financial and prayer support for all those who work in the foreign missions, the Summer Mission Appeal also invites us to think about our role as missionaries. The Church is missionary in nature, always seeking to bring the message of Jesus out into the world and bring people to respond with faith to that message. We don't have to go to foreign countries to be missionaries in this way. There are many people right here who need to hear the message of Christ. There are plenty of places right here where that message needs to be heard. We have to be the missionaries who bring the message of Jesus to these people and places.

While we don't always think of ourselves as missionaries, we should. This idea of being missionaries is something we will be hearing a lot about as we move forward into the next phase of the *Renew My Church* initiative. Even though we did not have any structural changes take place here in our parish, *Renew My Church* is really about making disciples, building communities, and inspiring witness. We will be hearing the term, *missionary disciples*, a lot in the years to come. This is a reminder of the missionary nature of the Church. As members of the Church, we are to be missionary disciples who go outward and invite others to meet Jesus Christ and accompany them into the life of the community. This will be a major emphasis for all of us in the years to come. As we offer our support to those who work in the foreign missions this weekend, let's keep in mind that we are all called to be missionary disciples here at home.

Dear Parishioners, Most Holy Redeemer Parish, receive Fr. Robert who is coming to you this **Weekend August 6/7, 2022**, all the way from Uganda, to speak to on behalf Friends for Shalom for Uganda: a U.S. not-for-profit 501(c)(3) EIN #46-4226998, (65 N Ott Ave, Glen Ellyn, IL 60137), registered in Illinois to provide charitable assistance to Mary Queen of Heaven Community Medical Center, of St. Joseph's Parish Nyakyera, Archdiocese Mbarara, Ugan-

da (East Africa) and the people in the village of Nyakyera and the surrounding Ntungamo District in Uganda – East Africa. We're a non-political, non-sectarian, faith-based organization which has built the first dedicated Community Medical center to give the most vulnerable children, mothers and their families the opportunity to survive and thrive, so they can participate in the growth and development of their beautiful country.

In September 2012, faced with a great need for a better access to Quality Health Care, that is professional, accessible and affordable, the community through the help of people with selfless heart of supporting the poorest of the poor immediately embarked on the construction of the facility (<https://www.facebook.com/FriendsOfShalomForUganda/>). Given the enormous need of meeting the medical and health-related needs of the community, the faith component in each one of us pushed us further and further into action. While wandering in the hilly country side not in "a corn field" as in the movie *Field of Dreams (1989)*, like Ray Kinsella in the film, we had a strong whisper: "***If you build it, they will come.***" In January 2013 alone we attended 271 out patients, and June 2022 alone we attended 680, with 10 children delivered at the facility. "*If you build it they will come*" and the needs continue to grow, and the pregnant women that didn't know where to go, now can come and have antenatal services, deliver their babies and come back for maternal and child care services.

We are here to appeal to you for medical equipment for blood testing, diagnostic and laboratory services. We are in urgent need of an Ultrasound Scanner machine, Centrifuge, Hematology Analyzer and Motorcycle to do the outreach to provide inoculations and vaccination services. "*We know only too well that what we are doing is nothing more than a drop in the ocean. But if the drop were not there, the ocean would be missing something.*" St. Mother Teresa of Kolkata. Thanks for being that drop in the ocean with your generosity.
