A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

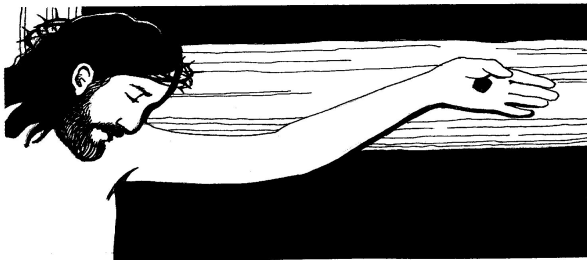
Twenty years ago, our nation was attacked by terrorists on September 11. I'm sure many of remember where we were and what we were doing when news of the attacks first came. Life in our country changed a great deal as a result of those attacks. While travel restrictions and other security measures might be the lasting effect of 9-11 for most of us, for many others the lasting legacy of those attacks is the loss of a husband or wife, a mother or father, a son or daughter, a brother or sister, a relative or friend. I hope we will try to keep in our prayers this weekend those who died in the attacks, and their families and friends who continue to feel the lasting effects of the loss of their loved ones.

Saturday, September 18, is the National Day of Remembrance for Aborted Children. Prayer services will be held throughout the country at the gravesites of aborted babies and other memorial sites dedicated in their honor. The prayer services will be dedicated to the memory of the more than 50 million children who have lost their lives to legal abortion since 1973, and to remind our society of the humanity of the unborn child. A prayer service will take place at St. Mary Cemetery at the gravesite of 500 aborted babies. Please try to attend this prayer service if you are able.

Next Sunday, we will have our annual Mass in the Park at 11:00 AM. This will be the first time in a couple of years we have been at Duffy Park for this event. Two years ago, we were in church because of rain. Last year, we couldn't have it because of the pandemic. It will be good to be back at Duffy Park for this Mass again. Pack your lawn chair and plan on joining us at 11:00 AM. If you want to make a day of it, our Most Holy Redeemer Raiders football teams will be playing after the Mass.

Our parish has been meeting with St. Bernadette and Queen of Martyrs as part of the *Renew My Church* initiative. On Wednesday, September 22, a very important meeting will take place in our church at 7:00 PM. Any parishioner who would like to attend this meeting is welcome to do so. This meeting will provide an opportunity to hear about what has been happening as we go through this initiative, which all parishes in the Archdiocese will go through. Some important information will be shared. We will also hear about changes that could possibly take place in our parishes as a result of *Renew My Church* and have the opportunity to ask questions and offer feedback. There will be further information about this meeting in the bulletin next weekend. The information will also be available at the parish website (www.mostholyredeemer.org). This meeting will be very important as we look to the future of the three parishes in our grouping. Please try to attend.

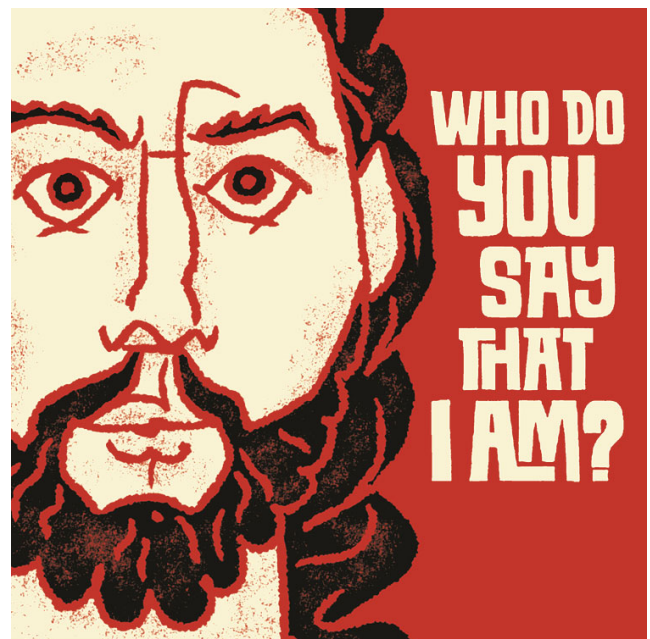
