A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

A few weeks ago, we had a *Renew My Church* parish meeting in the church. We heard about *Renew My Church*, saw the possible scenarios for our grouping, had the chance to ask questions, and offered our feedback. I want to again thank everyone who attended. Your feedback is very valuable as we move forward.

I want to let you know what is happening now in this process. Meetings such as ours were also held at St. Bernadette and Queen of Martyrs. They heard the same presentation and saw the same possible scenarios. They also offered their feedback. The feedback given at these meetings has been brought to our Grouping and Discernment Team meetings and forms an important component of the discussion. Please know that your feedback on each of the possible scenarios is being taken seriously in these discussions. A feedback summary is being prepared. This will be presented to the *Renew My Church* Commission's Executive Committee in December.

As our Grouping Team continues the task of prayerfully discerning and thoughtfully discussing the strengths and weaknesses of the various scenarios presented at our parish meeting, we would do well to keep some words from scripture in mind.

“Then an argument broke out among them about which of them should be regarded as the greatest. He said to them, “The kings of the Gentiles lord it over them and those in authority over them are addressed as ‘Benefactors’; but among you it shall not be so. Rather, let the greatest among you be as the youngest, and the leader as the servant. For who is greater: the one seated at table or the one who serves? Is it not the one seated at table? I am among you as the one who serves.” (Luke 22: 23-27)

This is a good passage for us to meditate on as it applies to our own lives. But it also applies in a special way to *Renew My Church*. As we think about what is best for the future of our parish and the other parishes in our grouping and our place in the renewal of the Church for the entire Chicagoland area, let's keep these words from scripture in mind. We are called to serve one another. How we can best serve one another will determine our future direction and any structural changes.

The *Renew My Church* prayer that we pray at each of our meetings was printed here previously. It is included again below. Please try to make this part of your daily prayer as we move forward in this process. As always, for more information, visit RenewMyChurch.org, or talk to me or any of the other team members.

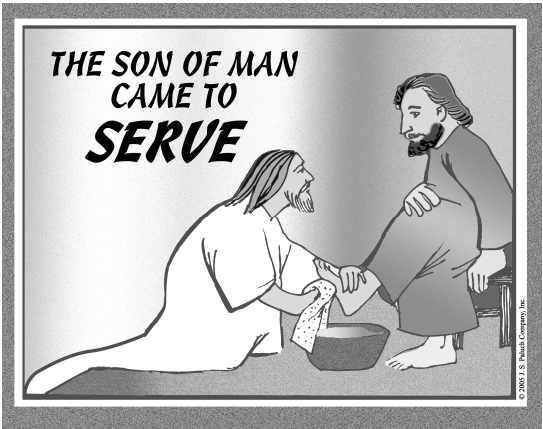

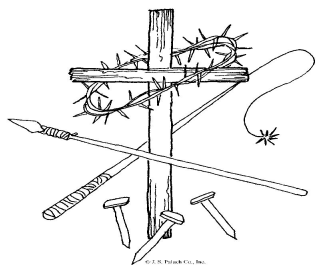
