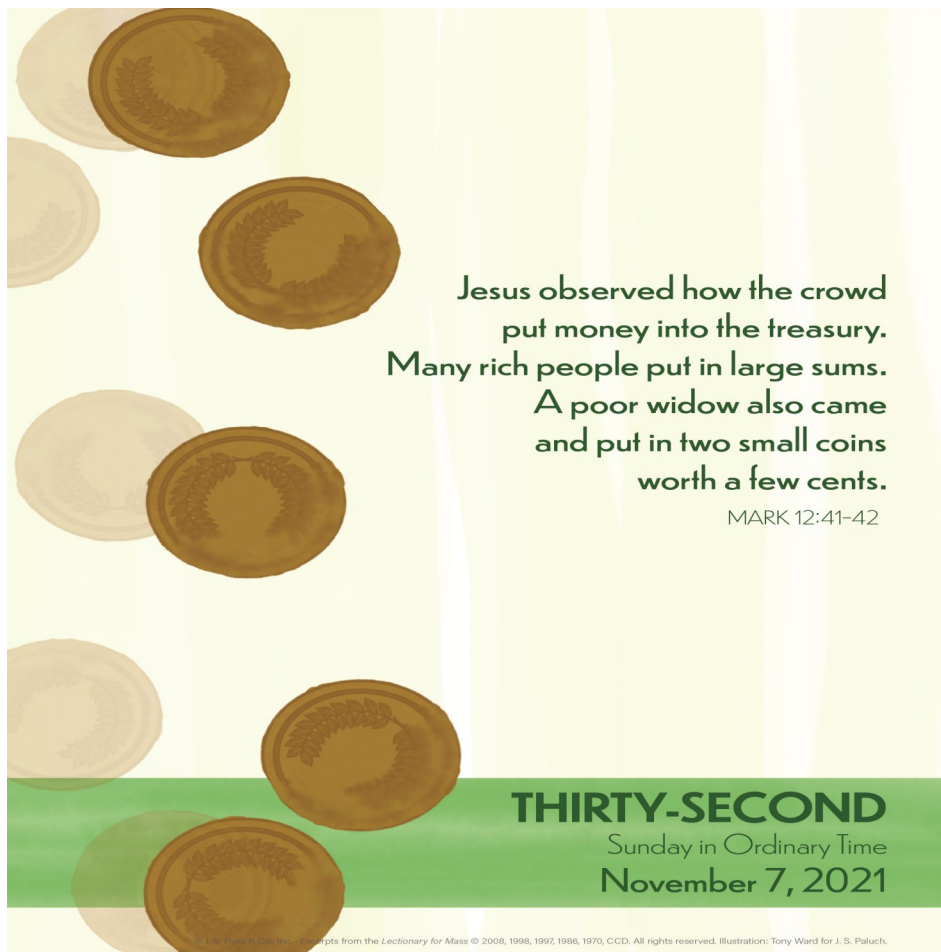


Today's Readings

With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we continue to build the Kingdom of God in our midst. Our vision is to foster the faith of all through prayer, service, education, and ministry.

A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Since the beginning of August, our Grouping Feedback and Discernment Team has been meeting with the teams from Queen of Martyrs and St. Bernadette in the *Renew My Church* initiative. We have been meeting every other week. We recently held the final meeting of our Grouping Feedback and Discernment Teams. While this part of the process may have ended, we are nowhere near finished. So, what comes next?

A member of each parish team is part of a writing team. It is the job of the writing team to go over the feedback received at the parish meetings. They compile the data collected at the parish meetings that took place in September into a Feedback Report. The report summarizes the strengths and challenges presented by each of the model scenarios presented at the parish meetings. The strengths and challenges come from the feedback given by parishioners at the meetings. While the final report has not been completed, the team members from each parish have been looking at it and suggesting edits and revisions at our last two meetings.

The writing team will continue to work on finalizing the report. A presentation will be made to the *Renew My Church* Executive Committee on Monday, December 13. After hearing our presentation about the strengths and challenges of each of the scenarios and asking questions, the Executive Committee will make a recommendation to the Presbyteral Council. The Presbyteral Council will vote on the recommendation. What is approved by the Presbyteral Council will be sent to the Cardinal. He will make the final decision about what happens and any changes that will take place. The Cardinal's decision is **tentatively** scheduled to be announced on January 25.

What should we do at this time? Pray. Pray for the writing team as they continue their work. Pray for the pastors and the team members who will be making the presentation to the Executive Committee on December 13. Pray for those who will be making the final decisions. Pray that we may be open to accepting whatever decision is made.
