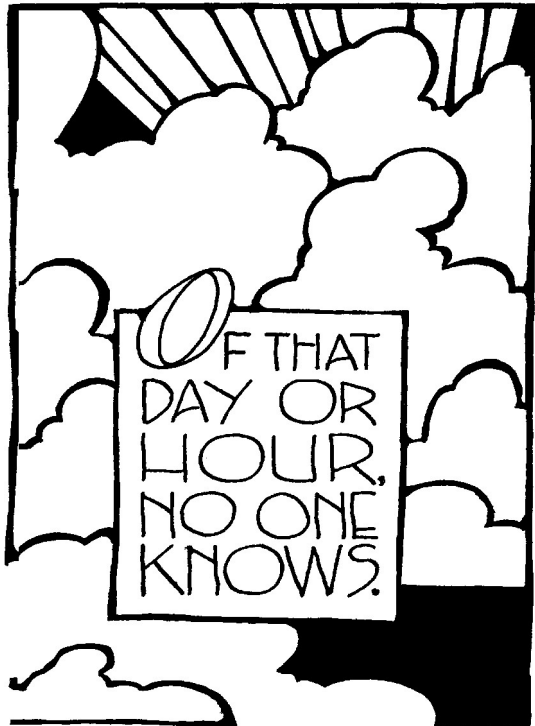

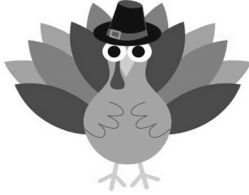
IMAGINATIVE PRAYER: IGNATIAN CONTEMPLATION
