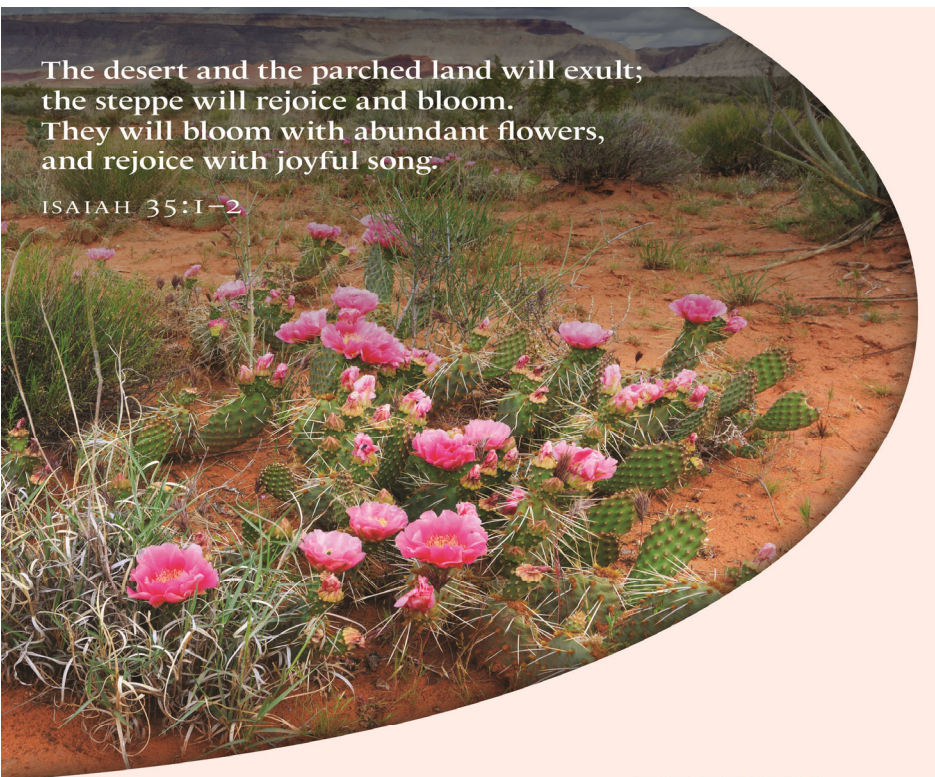


## Today's Readings

## MISSION STATEMENT

## **A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

In high school, I took four years of Latin and three years of Spanish. Our Spanish teacher believed that learning Spanish involved more than just learning the language, different nouns and verbs and tenses. It also involved learning the culture. So, we did things like go out for dinner at a Mexican restaurant. We learned about different holidays and customs. And at Christmas, we sang Christmas carols in Spanish. Some of the Spanish songs had English counterparts. For example, “Silent Night” in English became “Noche de Paz” in Spanish. Other carols that we learned are uniquely Spanish.

One of those uniquely Spanish carols was a carol called “Alegria.” The song spoke of the joy that filled the world at the first Christmas. The joy was because Mary and Joseph were on their way to Bethlehem. It was there that Jesus would be born. He is the reason for the joy of Christmas.

This weekend, we reach the halfway point of Advent. Two weeks are down. We have two weeks left until Christmas. The Third Sunday of Advent is often termed “Gaudete Sunday” from the Latin word for “joy.” The prayers and readings this weekend speak of the joy we are meant to be filled with as our celebration of the coming of Christ draws near.

If we find that we aren’t very joyful on this Third Sunday of Advent, we might want to think about that Christmas carol I learned in high school Spanish class. “Alegria” reminds us that Jesus is the reason for our joy. He is the source of our joy, at Christmas and always. If we aren’t joyful, maybe we need to include Him a little more in our preparations. Maybe we can try to pray more. Maybe we can practice more works of charity. Maybe we can seek reconciliation with a friend or family member we have grown apart from. Maybe we can seek reconciliation with our Lord in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. As the song reminds us, the more we include Jesus in our preparations for Christmas, the more joyful we will be. Let’s try to give Jesus a greater part in our preparations in these remaining days of Advent.

We have not had a Communal Reconciliation service since the pandemic started. As we continue to come back from the pandemic, we will be having a Communal Reconciliation prior to Christmas this year. Our Communal Reconciliation Service for Advent will take place on Wednesday, December 21, at 7:00 PM in the church. Please try to join us. We will also have extended hours for the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Saturday, December 17. Confessions will be heard on December 17 from 3:00 – 4:30 PM.

This weekend, 2023 calendars are available in church courtesy of Curley Funeral Home. If you’re looking for something to write on your new 2023 calendar, please reserve Saturday, January 14. Our Parish Appreciation Party will return that evening following a COVID hiatus. This event thanks ALL who volunteer to help our parish in any way during the year. If you helped out in any way, great or small, you are welcome to attend this party. It begins at 6:00 PM in Briody Hall. There is no cost to you. This is our way of thanking you. More details will be coming, but please reserve the date and plan on joining us.

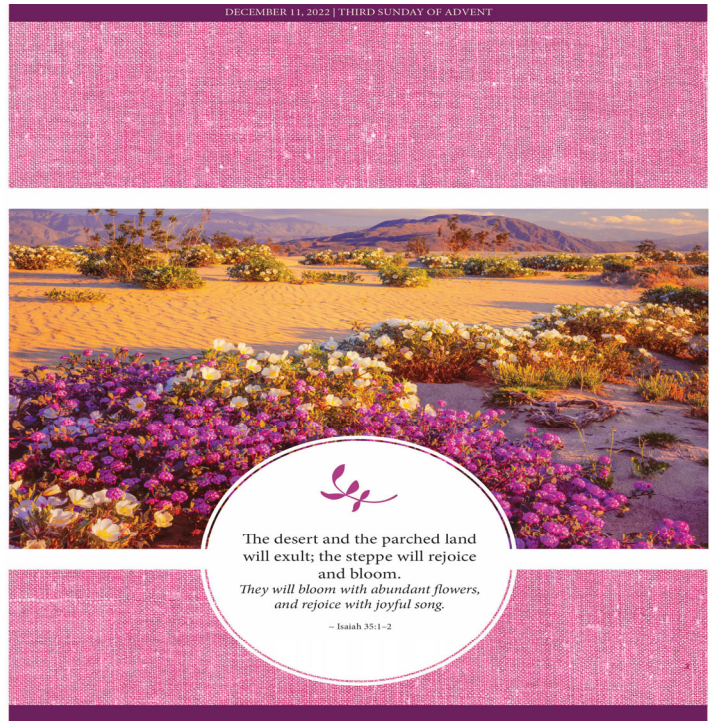

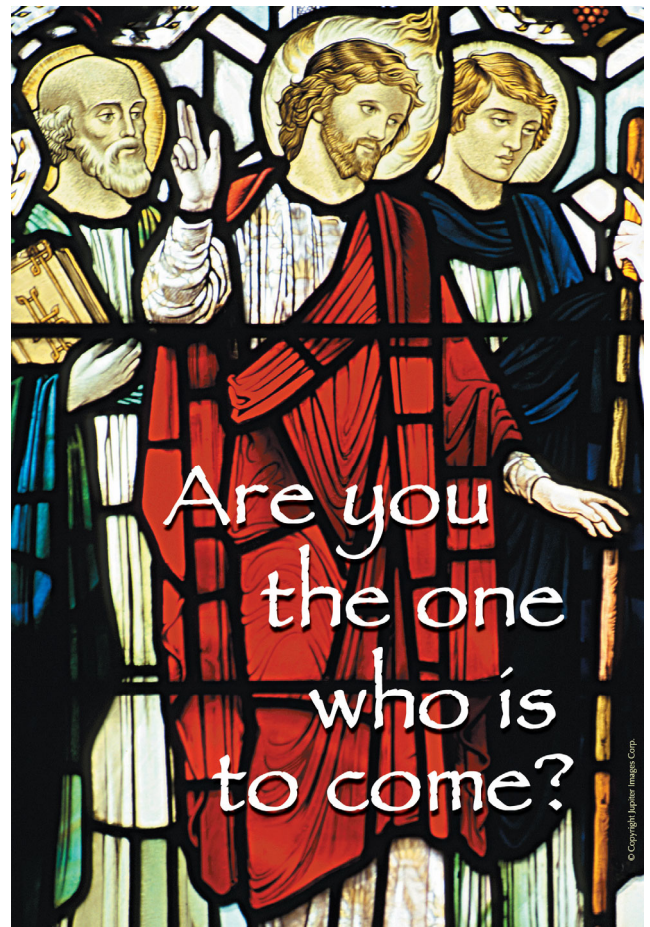
