

### **A Message From The Pastor**

This Monday is the 51<sup>st</sup> anniversary of the Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision that legalized abortion. Even though that decision has been overturned, all that has happened is that the issue has been returned to the states. Each state is able to decide whether or not abortions will be allowed in that state. Even though Roe v. Wade was overturned, there is still a long way to go to restore respect for life. The United States bishops have asked that January 22 be observed as a Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. As we have done in previous years, we will hold a Holy Hour for Life following the 8:30 AM Mass on Monday. Please try to join us if you can.

There are a few other upcoming dates to keep in mind. Friday, February 2, is the Feast of the Presentation of our Lord. According to Jewish law, a firstborn male child belonged to God. 40 days after birth, the child would be brought to the temple and presented to God as a way of saying the child belonged to God. The parents would then offer a sacrifice to redeem the child back so they could take him home and raise him. This day is also known as Candlemas Day. It is the day on which candles for use in church are blessed. Candles may also be blessed for religious use in homes. On February 2, we will be blessing candles at Mass which we will use in church throughout the year. If you have any candles you would like blessed for religious use in your home, you may bring them to mass on February 2. Please place them on the altar rail before Mass begins.

Saturday, February 3, is the feast of St. Blase. St. Blase is honored as the patron saint of diseases of the throat. On his feast day, it is customary to have our throats blessed, asking God, through the intercession of St. Blase, to protect us from all diseases of the throat and every other illness. Throats will be blessed following the 8:30 AM Mass on Saturday, February 3. A general blessing of throats will also be given at each of the Sunday Masses that weekend.

On Saturday, February 24, we will have our annual Parish Appreciation Party. This is to thank all of our volunteers who give of themselves in so many ways throughout the year. Anyone who gives of their time and talent to help our parish in any way, great or small, is invited to come. It doesn't matter how much you do or what you do, whether you help with everything or just one event per year, please come to the Appreciation Party so we can say, "Thank you." The Appreciation Party begins at 6:00 PM in Briody Hall. Dinner is served at 7:00 PM. There is no charge for this event since it is our chance to thank you for all you do for our parish. Please RSVP to the rectory (708-425-5354) to let us know if you will be attending and if you will be bringing a guest. It's a very enjoyable evening. Please try to join us.

#### #GivingTuesday with The Society of Saint Vincent de Paul, Chicago


