## **A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

On Tuesday evening at 6:30 PM, Bishop Andrew Wypych, our regional bishop and Cardinal Cupich's representative to our region of the archdiocese, will join us for prayer and to share an important announcement about the future of our parishes. This event will take place online. Please go to [www.renewmychurch.org/announcements](http://www.renewmychurch.org/announcements) for details about how to access the meeting from your computer or smartphone. If you do not have the capability to watch this on a computer or smartphone, please call the rectory (708-425-5354). If enough people want to watch but lack a computer or smartphone, we can try to set something up where the announcement can be viewed in the church or another meeting area.

When you go to the website, you will find twelve parish groupings listed about which announcements are going to be made. Find the "Evergreen Grouping." There will be a link to click on in order to register. Once you register, information will be sent to the e-mail address you provide so you will be able to view the announcement. The evening will begin with a prayer service. After the prayer service, the announcement will be made.

The announcement will be about any structural changes taking place among St. Bernadette, Queen of Martyrs, and Most Holy Redeemer as the initial phase of the *Renew My Church* initiative. Structural changes would include parish unifications or closings. Any changes would be based on the feedback collected at the meetings held at each parish last September. I want to thank the members of our Grouping Feedback and Discernment Team: Pat Enright, Lee Ann Arethas, Ron Balsewich, Chris Brett, Nicole Cushing, and Dan Turney for all the hours they put in on this team. Their efforts are greatly appreciated.

Whatever the announcement is, please keep in mind that this is just the start. The real goal of *Renew My Church* is not to change parish structures but to renew our faith and renew the Church. We are to make disciples, build communities, and inspire witness. We are to renew our own faith, making it a more active and visible part of our lives. We are to live our faith out in such a way that it draws others to Christ and to the Church. That is going to be the mission and focus of the Church and of our parishes for years to come. Whether or not any structural changes take place, a change to our minds, hearts, and lives will have to take place if our Church is going to grow and thrive.

Change is never easy. It does demand that we be flexible and open to change. Our Lord spoke of this when He talked about putting new wine into new wineskins. New wine is still fermenting and giving off gas. If you put new wine into an old wineskin that is hard and brittle, the skin won't be able to handle the fermentation and will burst. A new wineskin, which is still flexible, is needed. No matter what the announcement is on Tuesday, change is going to come as a result of that. Even if no structural changes take place, we will still be asked to work together more in the future with the other parishes in our community. We will have to see ourselves as co-workers rather than the competitors we have often been in the past. We will have to change our lives as well. I hope we will be willing to be new wineskins.

On a trip to Germany many years ago, I took part in something called the "New Wine Festival." This is an annual event that takes place every fall. The new wine is wine that has barely started to ferment. You are given a small pitcher of the new wine to drink. While for many people it would not be fall without taking part in the New Wine Festival, the new wine is not very good. The best thing about it is that the new wine eventually becomes old wine. There will be changes that come our way as a result of *Renew My Church*. These changes may be like new wine. They may not taste very good and may be hard to swallow. Hopefully, we can be the new wineskins who give the new wine brought to us by *Renew My Church* the chance to become old wine.




