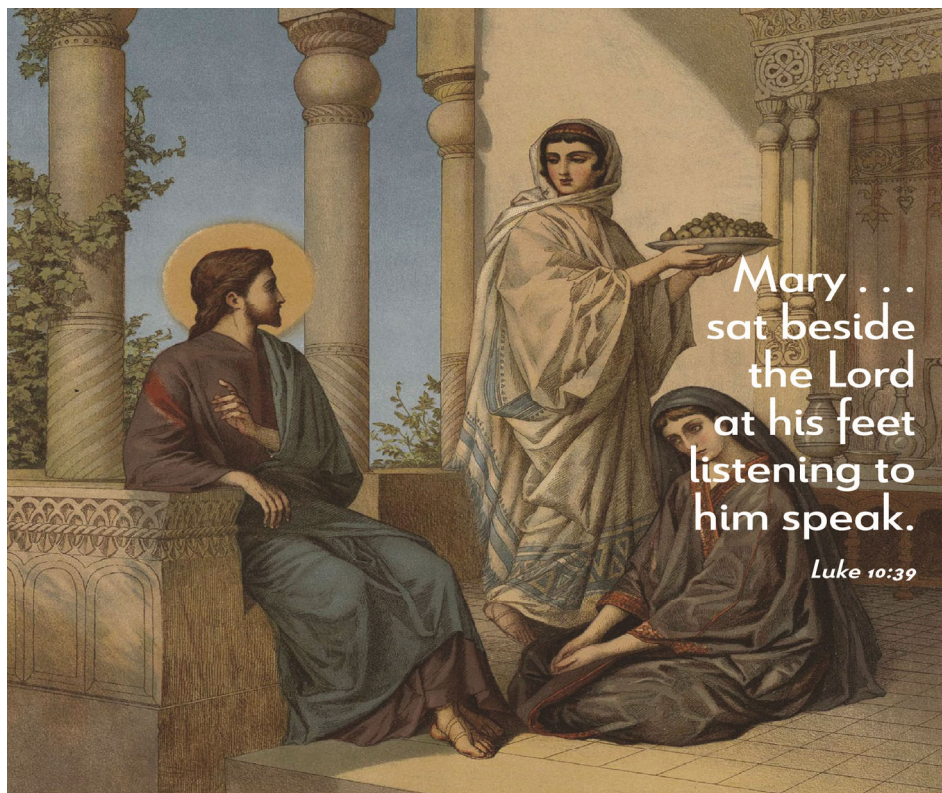

## A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

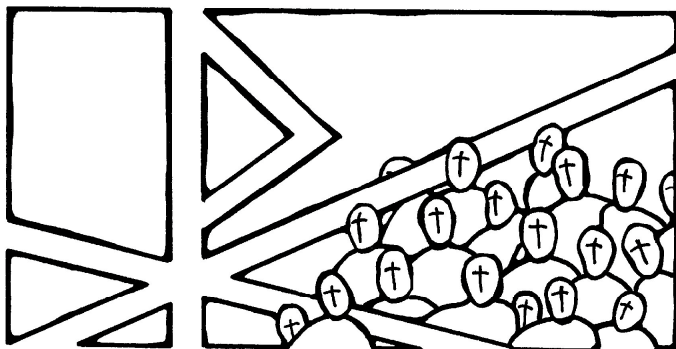
