## **A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

One of the first things I bought after I was ordained was a book called, *Saint of the Day*. It came in two volumes and provided information about each saint whose feast day was celebrated in the liturgy throughout the year. The information in the book often formed the basis for a reflection about the saint that I would give at daily Mass.

Over the past 41 years, a lot of new saints have been canonized or beatified and added to the liturgical calendar. My old *Saint of the Day* was no longer current. I had to get a new copy of it a few years ago that included many of the new saints. One of the saints included in the new copy is Blessed Solanus Casey. I was looking up another saint when I came across his story. It's pretty interesting.

Solanus Casey was born Bernard Casey in 1870 on a farm in Oak Grove, Wisconsin. His parents were Irish immigrants, and Bernard, or Barney as he was called, was the 6th of 16 children. He left the farm in his teens and worked as a logger, a hospital orderly, a streetcar operator, and a prison guard. While operating a streetcar, he witnessed a brutal murder. This made him want to make a difference in the world. He decided that ordained ministry would be the way to do it.

He entered St. Francis Seminary in Milwaukee but found the studies very difficult. Advised that he might be better off joining a religious order he left St. Francis and joined the Capuchins in Detroit. He took the name Solanus when he entered the Capuchins. He was ordained in 1904, but because his knowledge of theology was considered weak, he was not allowed to hear confessions or preach. This might have discouraged anyone else, but not Solanus.

He served in monasteries near New York City and Detroit. Not being able to hear confessions or preach limited Solanus to serving as a sacristan and a porter. A porter was the person who answered the door when someone knocked or rang the bell. Solanus set out to be the best porter he could be. People who came to the monastery found Solanus to be very welcoming. He was willing to listen to their problems, offer them good advice, and assure them of God's love. His reputation began to spread. It reached the point that on an average day, 150 – 200 people would come to the monastery just to talk to him. He started a prayer service every Wednesday afternoon for the sick. He was considered by many to be instrumental in cures and other blessings they received. He inspired others to do good things, such as get the Capuchins and his friends to start a soup kitchen during the Great Depression. That soup kitchen continues to feed the hungry today. He died in 1957 in Detroit. It was estimated that over 20,000 people passed by his coffin, a tribute to the lives he had touched and the people he had inspired by being the best porter he could be.

That might be something good for us to keep in mind. It's certainly good to want to improve ourselves. Having the ambition to strive to become better or to do greater things is certainly good. But we can learn from Blessed Solanus Casey that we can also do great things not by striving to be something else, but by striving to be the best of what we are. In his case, it was being the best porter he could be. In our case, it will no doubt be something different. Whatever it is, let's strive to be the very best we can be at it.

Fr. Tom Hurley is going to begin helping us out on occasion with Masses at our parish. We appreciate his willingness to help us out. It will no doubt be a nice break if you're getting tired of "All Hyland, all the time." We welcome Fr. Hurley.

**MAKING THE DIFFICULT CHOICE**

When my kids were in grade school, occasionally they would come home with an invitation to a birthday party. They'd rush in the door with their hair flying, all out of breath, stuttering and stammering that they were invited to a party!!! If I was lucky, the party was the next day. Usually, though, it was for the following weekend, which meant several days of "When is it Saturday?" And, of course, we had to make the trip to the store for the THE GIFT. It had to be the perfect present. After a few hours we eventually narrowed it down to a choice of four or five things. The actual decision was often very excruciating.

There were times, however, when my children came home from school in tears because they **were**'t invited to a party. Even though the school policy was that everyone had to receive an invitation or they could not be handed out at school, that wasn't always the case. Nothing is more painful than to see your child hurt because they were not included. My emotions would be overwhelming because seeing their pain often dredged up my own memories of exclusion and how isolated I felt when left out.

It's really funny how important feeling you belong is to human beings. Depending on how accepted we were in childhood so often affects the rest of our lives. Just imagine! Five or six short

years can determine the shape of the next seventy!!! It makes it all the more important that we teach our children to be open, tolerant and inclusive of those that are different from us.

There are several ways to do that, but I think one of the most important is by our own example. It's easy to **tell** our children that they should be nice to those that are different, but **showing** them is sometimes even more difficult. It's hard for me because when I see someone who is distinctly different from myself, my first feeling is to be afraid. And when I'm afraid I 'back-off,' try not to even talk to them. I have to make a special effort to get past my uneasiness and be welcoming. That's a side of myself that's important for my kids to see, too. Not just that I'm being nice, but that I work at it all the time.

Perhaps you feel a bit of uneasiness about volunteering to be a catechist. That's okay. We all sometimes feel inadequate when it comes to sharing our faith. But just as Jesus challenges his listeners to do something hard, he often calls his disciples to do the hard thing, too. We can only benefit from it, though, as will our children who will learn from our example that even though it is difficult, it is worth doing.
