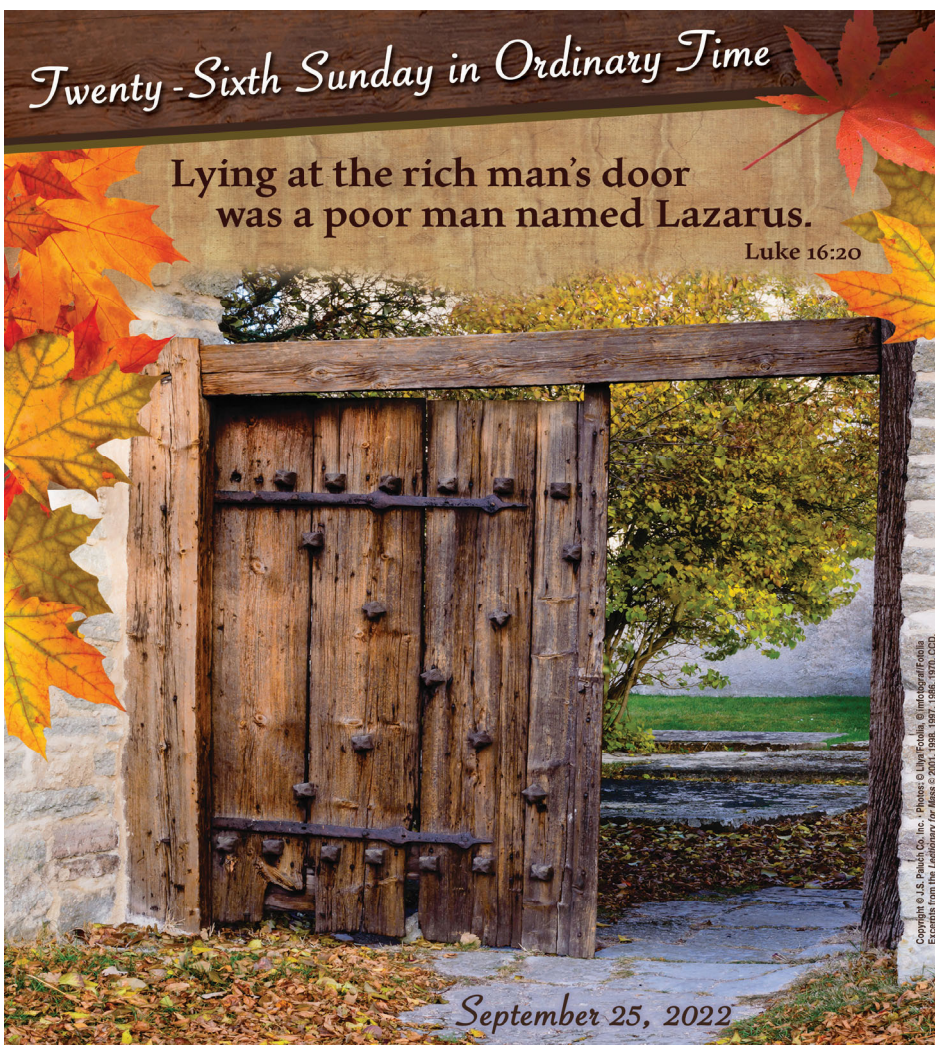

## **A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

Next weekend, we begin the annual October Mass Count. Every year, parishes in the Archdiocese are asked to count the number of people attending Mass each Sunday. Those numbers are used for long-range planning by the Archdiocese.

As we went through the initial phase of the *Renew My Church* initiative, I hope we came to realize how important the Mass Count numbers are. Many of the closings of some parishes and the unification of others was driven by the fact that there were not enough people attending Mass for those parishes to thrive. Without people attending Mass, the financial resources were not available to keep those parishes going either. The first duty of a parish is to worship our Lord in the celebration of the Eucharist. When the people of a parish commit themselves to doing that every Sunday, that parish will usually thrive. When the people of a parish have their primary commitment somewhere else or to some other aspect of parish life, that parish will often struggle.

When we went through the initial phase of *Renew My Church*, it was decided that our parish would continue on without having to make any structural changes. One reason for this was because the Archdiocese had set an October Mass Count of 800 people as the benchmark for viability. If a parish fell below that number, it would likely be uniting with a neighboring parish. If a parish was way below that number, closing was a definite possibility. The numbers used for *Renew My Church* came from the 2019 October Mass Count, which was the last count pre-COVID. Our count then was 862. In the Mass Counts we have done since then, our number has been well below that 800 benchmark. We need to change that.

Just because no structural changes to our parish took place in the initial phase of *Renew My Church*, it doesn't mean no structural changes will ever take place here. If our numbers continue to decline, a change could very well take place in the years ahead. That is why it is in our best interest to commit ourselves to worshipping our Lord in the celebration of the Eucharist every Sunday.

I hope you will make that commitment for the Sundays in October. I hope you will make it during the rest of the year too. Please attend Mass at Most Holy Redeemer. We can't count you if you're not here. Attending Mass somewhere else might be fine for fulfilling the Third Commandment, but it's not going to help us here at our parish. While the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass that went into effect when the pandemic began has not yet been lifted by the Cardinal, most of us are back to our regular activities. Attending Mass in person should be one of those regular activities we get back to. I hope to see you over the coming weeks and beyond. Let's try to get our Mass Count number back up there. It's important to the future of our parish that we do.

Next Saturday, October 1, the Communal Anointing of the Sick will take place at the 4:30 PM Mass. All the sick and elderly of the parish are invited to receive this sacrament of healing. The Anointing of the Sick at times will bring physical healing. What it always brings is spiritual healing. It lets the sick person know that the Lord is with them. The sacrament brings the graces to have hope for recovery and to bear illness well, not taking out your suffering on others. Celebrated communally, it also lets the sick know that they are not alone in their suffering. Others suffer too. It also lets them know they have the prayers and support of their parish, and of the entire Church. If anyone wants to receive the Anointing of the Sick but is unable to attend the Mass next Saturday, please contact the rectory (708-425-5354) so we can make arrangements for you to receive this sacrament in your home.

### VILLAGE STREET AND CURB PROJECT

Beginning Wednesday, September 14<sup>th</sup>, the village will begin work on the streets and curbs around Most Holy Redeemer. As you may have seen along other streets in the neighborhood, during construction, there are holes and trenches, with cones and construction barriers, in the streets and on the sidewalks. Parking and walking in the construction areas is hazardous and should be avoided.

Phase III begins Sept. 23: The south side of 96<sup>th</sup> Street from Millard Ave. to Lawndale Ave. Both parking lot entrances are open during Phase III. *It is recommended that you not park or walk along the south side of 96<sup>th</sup> street from Lawndale to Millard.*

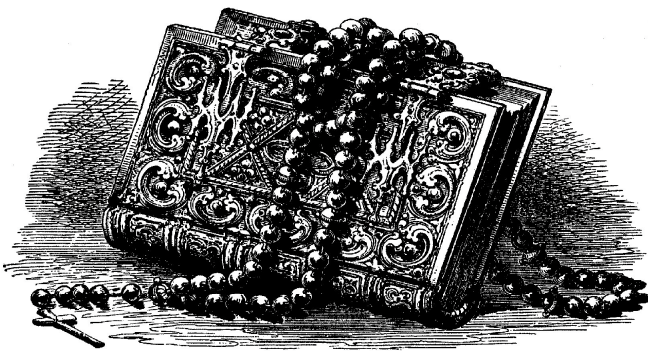

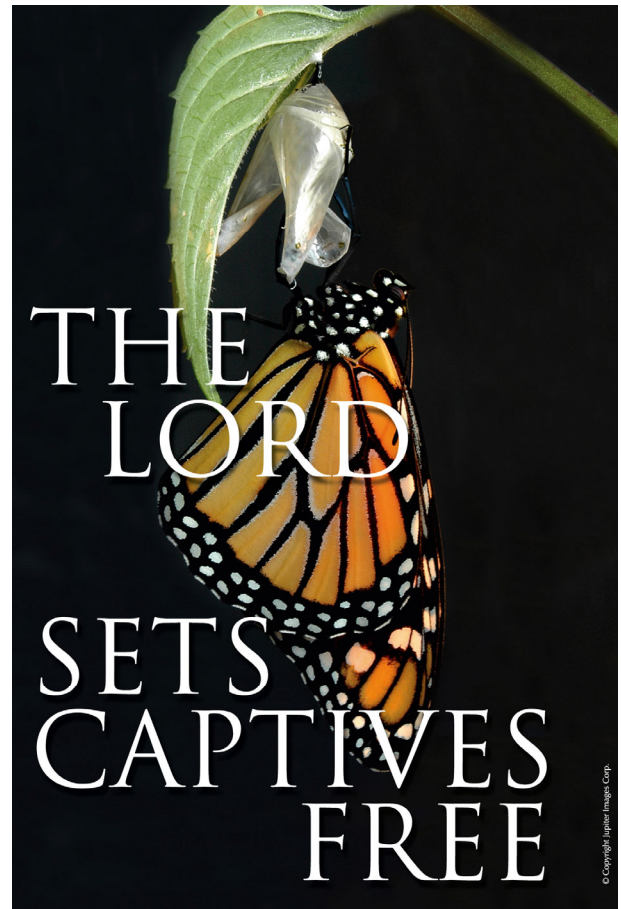
