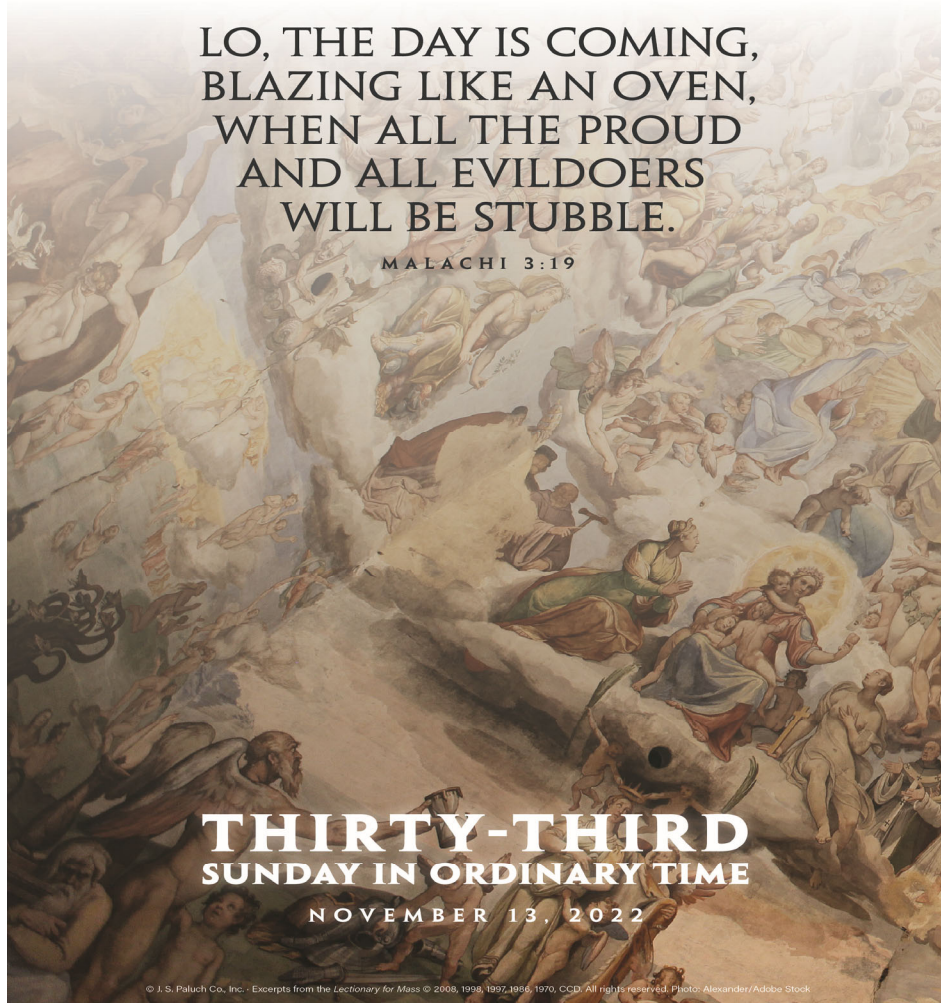


Today's Readings

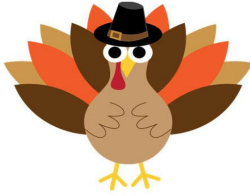


WE ARE LOOKING FOR **SUBSTITUTE CATECHISTS**
