Saint Paul Letters Project

This year during some of our class sessions, our Seventh Graders will be writing letters to their fellow School of Religion students about the Experiences that we share together in church on Monday nights (Mass, Rosary, Reconciliation, Stations of the Cross, etc). Throughout the year, our 7th graders will be learning about Saint Paul and discussing some of the letters that he wrote to different Christian groups during his ministry in which he spread the gospel message. The students will write their own personal letter (using suggested prompts) about our Monday night experiences. Then they will visit the classrooms to read the letters to other students. We are demonstrating the importance of encouraging others in our faith by giving them the opportunity to share their personal story of faith, just as Saint Paul did. **This project will be done in class only, but the expectation is that all students will fully participate.*
