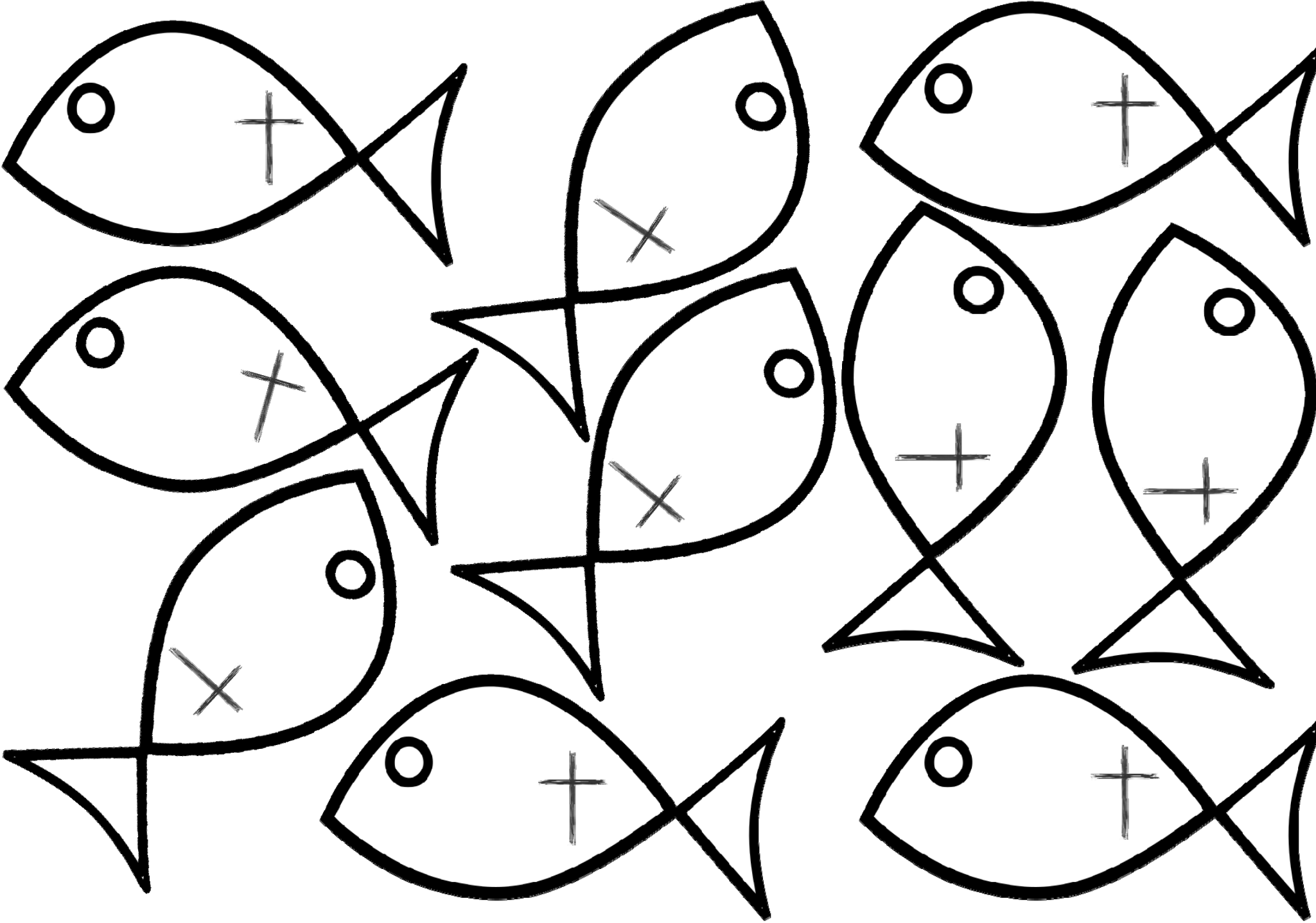


## First Eucharist Sacramental Guide

<b>May Crowning</b>	Yourself - prayerfully with your family	Sunday, May 5 <sup>th</sup> 11am Mass

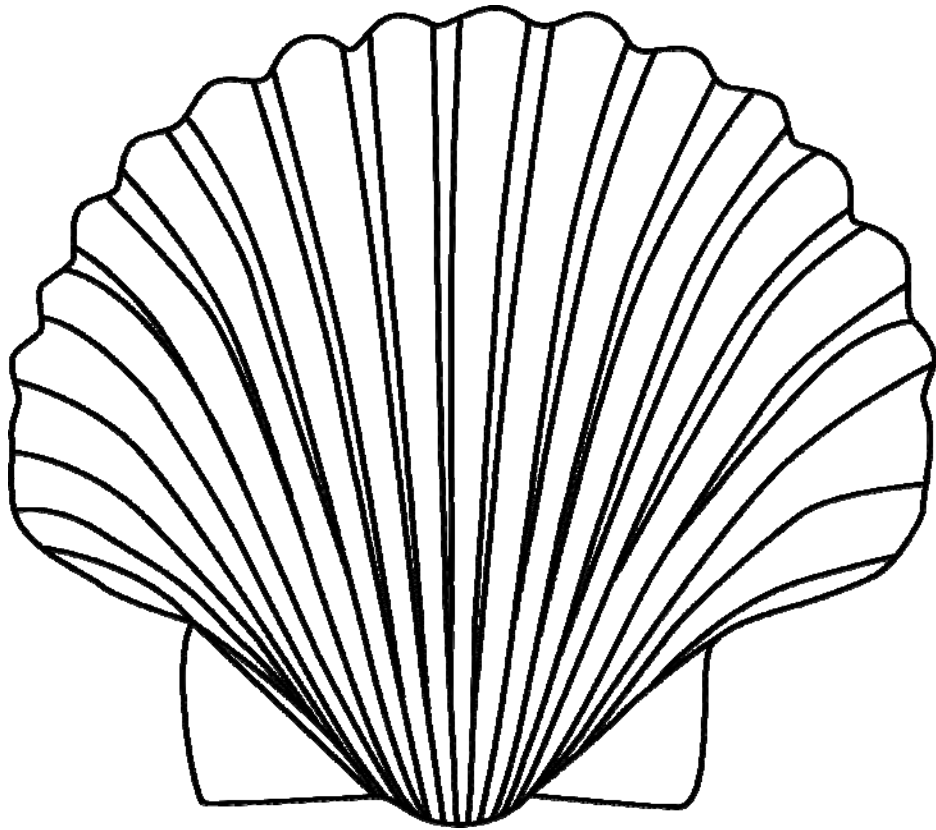
