A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Memorial Day started out as Decoration Day. Decoration Day honored the soldiers who died during the Civil War by decorating their graves. Decoration Day eventually transitioned to Memorial Day, a day to honor all those who have given their lives in military service to our country. This true meaning of Memorial Day tends to get lost today. This is the first holiday weekend of the summer season. Schools are getting out and graduations are taking place. WE think about getting our summer homes ready if we have them or firing up the backyard grill for the first time. The fact that we can enjoy the holiday in these ways is only due to those who were willing to pay the ultimate price so that we can live in freedom and safety. We owe them a great debt and should certainly keep them in mind on Memorial Day.

I was reading something recently about “Memorial Day Etiquette.” The article stated that it is in bad taste to wish someone a “Happy Memorial Day.” Memorial Day honors those who died in military service to our country. It is a somber day, and for those who lost a loved one in military service, far from a happy day. The article also stated that Memorial Day is not a day to thank a veteran. Memorial Day is a day to honor the dead, not the living. While it’s certainly good to thank veterans for their service, it is better done on a different day. Some appropriate ways to observe Memorial Day would include attending a parade or a military memorial service. At the very least, we can take a moment from our other activities to spend a moment in silence and in prayer to remember all those who have given their lives in military service to our country and made it possible for us to observe Memorial Day as we do. I hope that we will all find some time for that on Memorial Day.

A few weeks back, I mentioned the National Eucharistic Congress that will take place in Indianapolis July 17-21. There are four Eucharistic processions traveling through the country that will converge in Indianapolis. One of the processions will pass through the Chicago area June 26-30. Each Vicariate will have a special Mass to observe the procession. The Mass for Vicariate VI will take place at 7:00 PM on Saturday, June 29. St. Augustine Parish will host the Mass at St. Christopher Church, 4130 W. 147th Street, Midlothian, IL. The Mass will be followed by a sunset Eucharistic process. The Mass will be preceded by 24 hours of Adoration beginning on Friday, June 28, at 7:00 PM and continuing until that start of the Mass on Saturday. Each parish in the Vicariate is being asked to sign up to do an hour of Adoration during the 24 hours. Please contact me if you are interested in being part of an hour of Adoration and I will sign us up. We will also try to have a parish event while the procession is in the Chicago area. More details will follow.

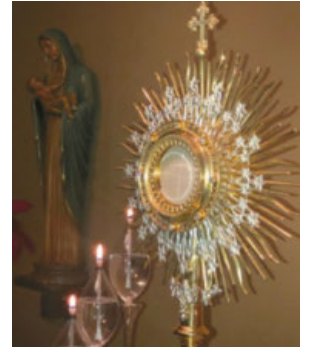
