## **A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

This is the time of year for graduations. The Class of 2024 graduated from Most Holy Redeemer School this past Friday. Many other schools have had, or will soon be having, their graduation ceremonies. We usually think of the word “graduate” in connection with receiving a degree or diploma in recognition of the successful completion of the course of studies at a certain level of one’s education.

The word “graduate” can also refer to measurement. A graduated cylinder, for example, is marked into intervals for optimal measuring. Thinking of that meaning of the word would tell us that graduation is not just the conferral of a degree or diploma. It also asks how we measure, maybe especially how we measure the success of those who graduate.

Very often, we will measure success according to the graduate’s grades. Did the person graduate with honors or make the Dean’s List? What was the graduate’s Grade Point Average? We can also measure success in terms of what someone does after graduation. What kind of job does the graduate go on to have? Maybe we will measure success according to salary and how much a person earns.

As believers in our Lord though, the measure of our success should be something else. The measure of our success will be not what our grades were or what we earn. The measure of our success will be the kind of people we become. Do we try to be good disciples, people who try to follow our Lord in all we do? Do we try to serve others, especially the least of our brothers and sisters and make life better for them? Are we honest people? Is that more important to us than getting ahead? Are we kind to others? Do we try to avoid doing or saying things that will harm other people or their reputations? Do we try to live by the moral standards of the gospel? In the end, these measures of our success will be much more important than what our grades were, or what kind of job we had, or how much money we made.

I hope that all graduates from our parish will keep this in mind. We are very proud of them for graduating, for receiving their diplomas and degrees. We will be even prouder of them if they measure their future success not by standards of wealth or prestige, but by the standards our Lord presents us with. Congratulations to all the 2024 graduates from our parish!

I hope that you are planning on joining us for our Parking Lot Party on Saturday, June 15. This event took the place of the Carnival last year. It was a great time last year, and we are hoping it will be an even better time this year. Your attendance and support are vital. We will have music, our Grand Raffle, split the pot drawings, a raffle for tickets to some major entertainment events, and more. The band for the evening is "Run Forrest Run. They bill themselves as "The Ultimate 90's Party Band." (If you want a preview, go to youtube.com and search for Run Forrest Run Band.) Further details can be found in the bulletin.
