## **A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

We received some sad news earlier this week. Fr. Joe Hardy passed away last Sunday in Canada at the age of 90. Fr. Hardy was born in Chicago on July 28, 1933. The family moved to Canada when he was young. He worked in banking before answering the call to the priesthood. He was ordained a priest on May 29, 1965, for the Diocese of London, Ontario, on May 29, 1965. Fr. Hardy served in many parishes in the London diocese. He retired in 2003 and began splitting time between Canada and the United States. We were blessed to have Fr. Hardy serving us here at Most Holy Redeemer for many years. He loved being with people and especially enjoyed nurturing the faith of young people. Services were held for Fr. Hardy this past week in Canada. We will have a memorial Mass for him here [at a later date](#). Please keep Fr. Hardy and his family in your prayers.

Next Saturday, June 15, we will be having our 2<sup>nd</sup> “Parking Lot Party.” We did this last year as a replacement for the Carnival which was cancelled due to concerns about safety. It was [very successful](#) financially, and everyone who attended had [a great time](#). So, we decided to do it again. We will have the “Run Forrest Run Band” with us for the evening. But those who win the additional prizes will win more. Raffle tickets were mailed to all registered parishioners. They are \$50.00 each, or 3 for \$100.00. Tickets can be returned to the rectory or on the night of the party. Tickets for the raffle can also be turned in this weekend after the 9:30 and 11:00 AM Masses in the church vestibule. Raffle tickets will also be available for purchase.

In addition to the Grand Raffle, there is another raffle for some great entertainment packages. Tickets for this raffle are \$100.00 each. Only 100 tickets will be sold. There will be split-the-pot raffles and other games. I hope you will support this event by attending it. I also hope you will turn in your raffle tickets and have a chance at winning.
