## **A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

“You can go a lot farther with a kind word and a machine gun than you can with just a kind word.” I recently saw that statement in an article I was reading about “Famous Last Words.” According to the article, that statement about kind words and a machine gun were among the last words of gangster Al Capone. A little research raised some issue as to whether those really were Al Capone’s last words and if he even said them at all. That seemed to be the case with many of the famous last words mentioned in the article. I had always heard that the last words of actor Humphrey Bogart were, “I never should have switched from Scotch to martinis.” According to the article, Bogart’s last words were something else entirely.

One set of last words that were verified by more than one source were the last words of Leonardo da Vinci who said, “I have offended God and mankind because my work did not reach the quality it should have.” I was a bit flabbergasted when I read those words. How could Leonardo da Vinci feel that way? This was the artist who painted the *Mona Lisa* and *The Last Supper*. This was the scientist and inventor who came up with ideas for parachutes and flying machines, bridges that needed no support, and even a robot. How could he feel that his work did not reach the quality it should have? Maybe because his ideas for flying machines didn’t actually work?

What really struck me about Leonardo da Vinci’s last words was that if he felt that he had offended God and mankind because his work did not reach the quality it should have, then how should I feel? I’m certainly no Leonardo da Vinci, but it made me think about what I am doing with what God has blessed me with. Am I using the gifts and talents God has given me to the best of my ability? Would God be pleased with what I have done with those gifts? Have I used those gifts in a way that has been of benefit to other people? What am I doing with the gifts and talents God has blessed me with? What are any of us doing with the gifts and talents God has blessed us with?

A few weeks ago, I wrote in the bulletin about the summer months being a good time to reflect on our lives, about what we are doing and the direction we are going in. I find that Leonardo da Vinci’s last words would be something good for all of us to think about. What are we doing with all that God has blessed us with? We could also keep in mind the words (not his last ones) of theologian Hans Urs von Balthasar who said, “What you are is God’s gift to you. What you become is your gift to God.” What gift are we giving to God?

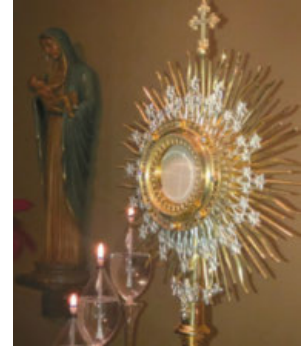
