## **A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

Every summer, parishes throughout the United States take part in the Summer Mission Appeal. This is an opportunity to hear about the work of missionaries around the world. It is also an opportunity to offer our prayer and financial support to the missionaries.

Next weekend, our parish will be taking part in the Summer Mission Appeal. We will welcome to our parish Fr. William Nordenbrock, C.P.P.S. Fr. Nordenbrock will speak at all the Masses next weekend. There will also be a second collection to help the missionaries in their work. Fr. Nordenbrock is a member of the Missionaries of the Precious Blood. The Missionaries of the Precious Blood believe that the redeeming power of the Blood of Christ brings healing to the world. Because Christ's Blood was shed for all, the [Missionaries](#) preach of Christ's all-inclusive love. Through their ministry, they seek to bring healing, hope, and reconciliation. Their spirituality calls them to seek out those who feel unloved, rejected, and alone, as Christ would. They serve around the world in parishes, colleges, schools, jails, and hospitals in inner city, suburban, and rural areas – wherever God calls them. I hope we will welcome Fr. Nordenbrock and be generous in our support of the missions next weekend.

The Summer Mission Appeal not only gives us the opportunity to learn about the work of missionaries and support them, but it also allows us to reflect on the missionary nature of the Church. Before Christ ascended into heaven, He told His Apostles, "Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature." Our Lord's words tell us that the Church is a missionary Church. We must always try to bring the gospel message to the people and places where that message has not been heard.

The missionaries we support through the Summer Mission Appeal certainly strive to bring the gospel message where it needs to be heard. But this is not just work for missionaries. It is work for all of us. While missionaries may go to foreign lands to preach the gospel, mission territory also exists a lot closer to home. There are people we all know who need to hear the gospel message. They might be family members or friends, neighbors or co-workers. What can we do to bring the good news of Jesus to them? There are places where the message of Christ needs to be heard. Maybe our workplace could use the gospel message. Maybe our neighborhoods could use the good news of Jesus. What if we tried to bring the message of Christ into the worlds of law, or medicine, or politics, or entertainment? The gospel message could certainly make a difference there. What can we do to bring the message of Christ to the people who need to hear it? How can we bring the message of Christ to the places where it needs to be heard? We are all called to take part in the missionary activity of the Church. While we do that through our prayers and financial support, our Lord may be calling us to a little more. I hope we will all consider that possibility as we take part in the Summer Mission Appeal.
