## A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

When Fr. Adamich died, his family came and cleaned out his room. When they were done, they told us if there was anything there that any of us wanted, we should take it. Fr. Adamich did not really have anything that I wanted, but there was a book on his shelf that caught my eye and that I did take. The book was called, *Jesuits Telling Jokes*. Maybe the book caught my eye because I have never found Jesuits to be particularly humorous. The book did nothing to change my opinion. Each chapter began with a joke. I'm sure you have heard jokes about the priest, the rabbi, and the minister who walked into a bar. Well, these jokes were about the Dominican, the Franciscan, and the Jesuit who walk into a bar. While the jokes may not have been all that funny, there was still some good stuff in the book.

One chapter began with a joke that wasn't all that great, but included a story about St. John Berchmans, a Jesuit of course. He was playing billiards one day, and while he was playing, he was asked, "What would you do if you only had a few more minutes to live?" He answered, "I would go on playing billiards." His answer may seem odd. John Berchmans knew though, that he could not change the past and did not know what the future held. All he could do was concentrate on the moment at hand, which happened to be playing billiards.

I think John Berchmans' words have something to say to us as we celebrate Labor Day. Labor Day honors all working men and women. It tells us that all workers are important. They have a dignity that comes from the work they do. They should be treated fairly and with respect. Labor Day also reminds us that all work is important, even the most menial tasks. Catholic teaching tells us that God did not leave us with a finished world when He rested on the seventh day. The work we do helps to carry on God's work of creation and bring it towards completion. Work should be done honestly and to the best of our ability. It's here that St. John Berchmans' words apply.

If we want to do our work to the best of our ability, then we need to focus on the task that is at hand. Just as St. John Berchmans focused on the billiard game he was playing, we should focus on the work that we are given to do. It is very easy to place our attention elsewhere. We might think about what we could be doing instead of the work that lies before us. We might think about the job we would really like to have instead of the one we do have. When we think like that, the odds of doing a poor job increase. By focusing on the task at hand, we will more likely do a better job. It doesn't apply just to work either. If I spend a lot of time thinking about what I could be doing instead of being a priest, I'm not going to be a very good priest. If a married man or woman spends an inordinate amount of time thinking about who else they could have married instead of the person they did, they're not going to have a great marriage.

As we celebrate Labor Day, this would be something to keep in mind. We celebrate the dignity and importance of all workers and the work they do. Since all work is important though, let's remember that we need to work to the best of our ability and do the best job we can. One way we can do that is to learn from St. John Berchmans to focus on the task at hand. We will do a better job with our work, and with a lot of other things, when we do. Get your lawn chairs ready. Next Sunday is our annual Mass in the Park. The 11:00 AM Mass next Sunday will take place at Duffy Park. We hope we will be blessed with good weather. Even more, we hope we will be blessed with your presence and participation at this annual event. Please plan on joining us.

Saturday, September 14, is the 12<sup>th</sup> Annual National Day of Remembrance for Aborted Children. In our area, a prayer service will take place at 10:30 AM at St. Mary Cemetery. The prayer service will take place at the burial site of 500 aborted babies found in a dumpster outside a Michigan Avenue clinic. Please join us if you can to pray that all human life will one day be legally protected from the moment of conception to the moment when life naturally comes to an end.

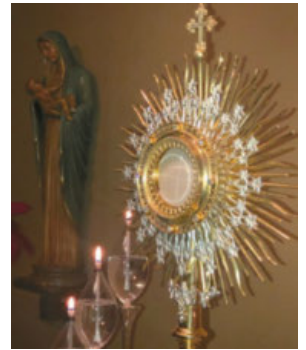
