## **A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

The *Christifideles Award* was established to honor an individual or married couple who have used their talents to deepen the life of the Church in the parish or who have served in an extraordinary way the ministry of the parish. Each parish is allowed to choose an individual or couple to receive the award. I am happy to announce that Tony and Noreen Signorelli will be the *Christifideles Award* winners from Most Holy Redeemer this year. Tony and Noreen do much of the coordinating for the Adoration Chapel. They are School of Religion catechists. Tony serves as a lector. They promote opportunities for prayer and try to deepen the spiritual life of our parish. They will be receiving the award at a prayer service at Holy Name Cathedral on Sunday afternoon. Congratulations to Tony and Noreen on receiving the *Christifideles Award*.

Next Saturday, October 5, we will have our annual Communal Anointing of the Sick at the 4:30 PM Mass. All the sick and elderly of the parish are invited to receive this sacrament of our Lord's healing. The Anointing of the Sick sometimes brings physical healing to the one who receives it. What it always brings is spiritual healing, letting the sick know our Lord is with them, giving them hope of recovery, giving them the grace to bear their illness well, and letting them know the prayers of the Church are with them. When celebrated communally, the sick and elderly realize they are not alone – that others are suffering too. When celebrated communally, they also realize more fully that the prayers of their fellow parishioners are with them. If you are not able to join us next Saturday at the 4:30 Mass but would still like to receive the Anointing of the Sick, please call the rectory (708-425-5354) so arrangements can be made for myself or Fr. Paul to anoint you in your home.

Next weekend, we begin the annual October Mass Count. Every October, parishes throughout the archdiocese are asked to count the number of people who attend Sunday Mass each week. The numbers are very important. They are used by the archdiocese in doing long-range planning. If you doubt the importance of those numbers, they played a big role in the first stage of *Renew My Church*. The October Mass Count numbers had a great deal to do with which parishes merged or closed and which ones were allowed to stand on their own. While we should attend Mass every Sunday, given the importance of the October Mass Count numbers, I urge you to make an extra effort to attend Mass each Sunday in October. Also, please attend Mass at Most Holy Redeemer. We can't count you if you are attending Mass somewhere else.

This coming Friday, October 4, is the feast of St. Francis of Assisi. Francis of Assisi was known for his love of the created world. He had a love of animals, and on his feast day, it is a tradition to have our pets blessed. The annual Blessing of Pets will take place on Friday, October 4, at 4:00 PM in the parking lot between the school and the rectory. All pets and their owners are invited to attend.

October is Respect Life Month. One way our parish will be observing Respect Life Month is with the Baby Bottle Project. Plastic baby bottles will be available in church. Please take one home, fill it with your spare change during the month, and bring it back to church at the end of the month. All the money collected will go to the Women's Centers to help them in their life saving work.

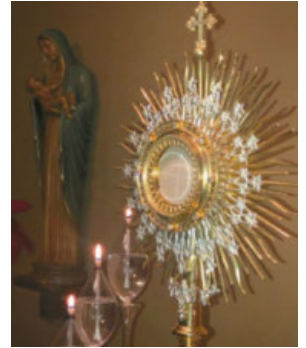

Like to sing? Play an instrument?

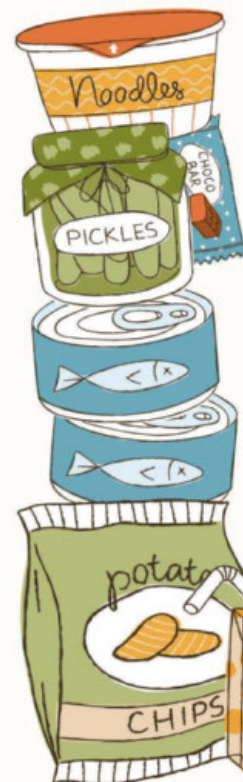
Want to be more involved in your Parish and share your faith?

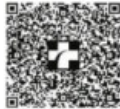

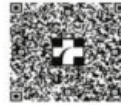
