## A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

It always surprises me how many people think the Twelve Days of Christmas are the twelve days leading up to Christmas. You might get that impression from the way we celebrate. We have all kinds of parties and grab bags and other events and activities in the days leading up to Christmas. Then, December 25 arrives, and all our celebrating comes to an end.

In reality, the Twelve Days of Christmas follow December 25. Christmas is the beginning of the celebration, not the end. This is the way we observe the season in the Church. The Christmas Season doesn't officially end this year until January 12 when we celebrate the Baptism of our Lord. In addition to Christmas, we celebrate many other wonderful feasts during this season such as the Epiphany, New Year's Day and the Motherhood of Mary, and the feast we celebrate this weekend, the Feast of the Holy Family.

God could have entered this world in any way He wanted to. God chose though, to be born into a human family. God must have seen something so special and unique about families that God chose to be part of one. Maybe that's because our God is a Trinity of Divine Persons united in love. The nature of God is a family of three Divine Persons united in love. While we are not Divine Persons united in love as the Trinity is, on this feast we can remember that our families are called to be persons united in love. This feast gives us something to strive for in our family life. We can strive within our families to be persons united in love. We will never reach perfection in that regard, but the more we strive to reach that goal, the happier and holier our family life will be.

It's interesting that we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family when we do. Family is a big part of our holidays, but to hear some people talk, they are not always happy to see their families, or certain members of their families. They are always happy when the holidays are over, and they don't have to see their families for another year. No family is perfect. Some members of our families can be very difficult to take. Despite that, let's try to see our families as a gift. Let's strive to make our families persons united in love.

The start of a new year is a time when we make resolutions. We resolve to change things about our lives. We resolve to lose weight or get in shape. We resolve to overcome a bad habit. Maybe we resolve to develop a talent or improve [ourselves](#) intellectually. While we strive for physical or intellectual improvement, we don't always think about spiritual improvement. That might be something we more often associate with Lent. We don't have to wait until Ash Wednesday though to try to improve ourselves spiritually. If you're tired of making the same resolutions that you end up breaking in a week or two, why not consider making a spiritual resolution this year, whether to attend Mass more regularly, spend more time in prayer, become more active in your parish, or try to follow our Lord more in your daily life? Since they are different from our usual resolutions, we may find them easier to keep. We may also find they make a much bigger difference in our lives.


